Radovich Pitches Spokane To Win

Bob Radovich, a Los Angeles Dodgers farmhand with their Spokane club in the Pacific Coast League, was working on a string of 27 1-3 scoreless innings today in a manner reminiscent of Sandy Koufax on the parent team.

A hard throwing right-hander, Radovich pitched seven frames of three-hit ball Tuesday night in hurling the Indians to a 1-0 triumph over the Dallas-Fort Worth Rangers.

He wobbled in the eighth and gave way to Ken Rowe who assured Radovich, who was a no-hitter this year, his fourth win against one loss. It was a tough defeat for Ted Sadowski (6-1) who went the distance for the Rangers and allowed only four hits.

Spokane remained on top of the PCL's Northern Division by 4½ games. San Diego handed Oklahoma City, the Southern Division pace-setters, a 7-5 setback but the others clung to their half-game lead over the Rangers in the southern race.

In other contests, Seattle took two from Salt Lake City, 5-3 and 4-1, Tacoma belted Portland, 10-1 and Denver and Hawaii split a twin bill. It was Denver 9-6 in the opener and Hawaii 8-4 in the nightcap.

Both Radovich and Sadowski retired 11 straight batters at different points in their duel at Spokane. John Werhas produced the game's lone tally in the sixth inning when he tripled across Rod Graber who had walked.

San Diego erupted for three runs in the eighth inning to wipe out a 5-3 deficit and defeat Oklahoma City. Leo Peden, recently deposed as manager of the Portland Beavers, started the big inning with a double. Two hits followed mixed in with an error that helped the rally keep going. Deron Johnson homered in the seventh off loser Ben Johnson (6-6). Scott Breeden (5-7) was the winner.

Jay Ritchie, usually a relief pitcher, turned in a six hitter for the Rainiers as they took the nightcap, 4-1, from Salt Lake and insured the sweep. A three-run burst in the first inning off Cal Koonce got the Suds off to a fast start. Billy Spanswick survived a rocky start in the opener and bested Gordy Seyfried, the Bees hard-luck hurler, 5-3.

The four hit pitching of Jerry Thomas and some hefty belting by Gil Garrido, who got four hits, paced Tacoma to its 10-1 win over Portland. Cap Peterson, who had a brief stay with the San Francisco Giants this season, also paced the Tacoma attack with three hits in as many trips while knocking in three runs. The Giants had a total of 16 safeties.

Losing pitcher Cal Browning accounted for the Beavers only run when he tripled in the fifth inning after a walk.

Denver's Steve Demeter continued his heavy stickwork in Honolulu, with his fourth and fifth homers of the series.

Ed Haas also had a homer in the first game and went 4-for-4. But it was Demeter's three-run

belt in the fourth that iced the contest for the Bees.

But in the nightcap, Hawaii got off to a 6-0 lead behind Dick Sovde's pitching and some steady stickwork.

Demeter and Lou Klimchick hit late-inning Denver homers, but Tom Morgan came on to put out the fire and save the win for Sovde.

Denver slugger Ethan Blackaby tossed his bat high into the air to protest a called strike in the first inning of the nightcap. The bat came down and Blackaby was tossed out.
