SWITCH REQUIRED

Only occasion when death of a vice president, after his nomination for a second term, necessitated selection of another candidate before the November elections was the death of James S. Total volume of timber sold during the year reached 5,314,311,000 board feet with a value of \$80,666,672.05. The stumps, sold to Heyden-Newport Chemical Corporation for chemical extraction, were in portions of the Deschutes, Winema, and Fremont national forests of Southern Oregon. But, without the stump volume, a sales record was established—with the total exceeding last year's figure by 14 million board feet.

Preliminary figures show a record 4,600,000,000 board feet of timber valued at \$78,643,379 was harvested on the national forests of Oregon and Washington in fiscal year 1963.

The harvest exceeds all past fiscal year figures by more than 400,000,000 board feet, reports J. Herbert Stone, regional forester, U.S. Forest Service.

'No Names Barred' Defense Hinted In Profumo Scandal

LONDON (UPI)—Dr. Stephen Ward, the playboy osteopath and artist who brought former War Minister John Profumo and call girl Christine Keeler together, went on trial today on charges of living off the earnings of prostitutes.

The trial drew national attention to the grimy Old Bailey Court building and one London newspaper, the Sunday Express, indicated that more scandals would be revealed when it proclaimed it "the opening of the debutante season."

Informal sources said the 30-year-old war minister, who moved among the top strata of British society, may wage a "no names barred" defense that could bring more scandals to public attention.

Lines of spectators began forming outside the court at 2 a.m. Thomas Gifford, 43-year-old social worker and criminologist, was first in line.

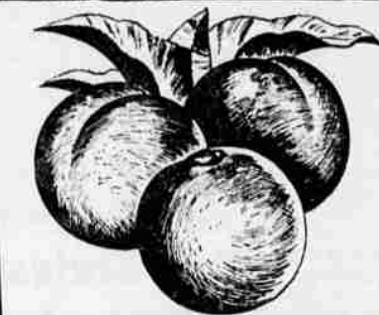
