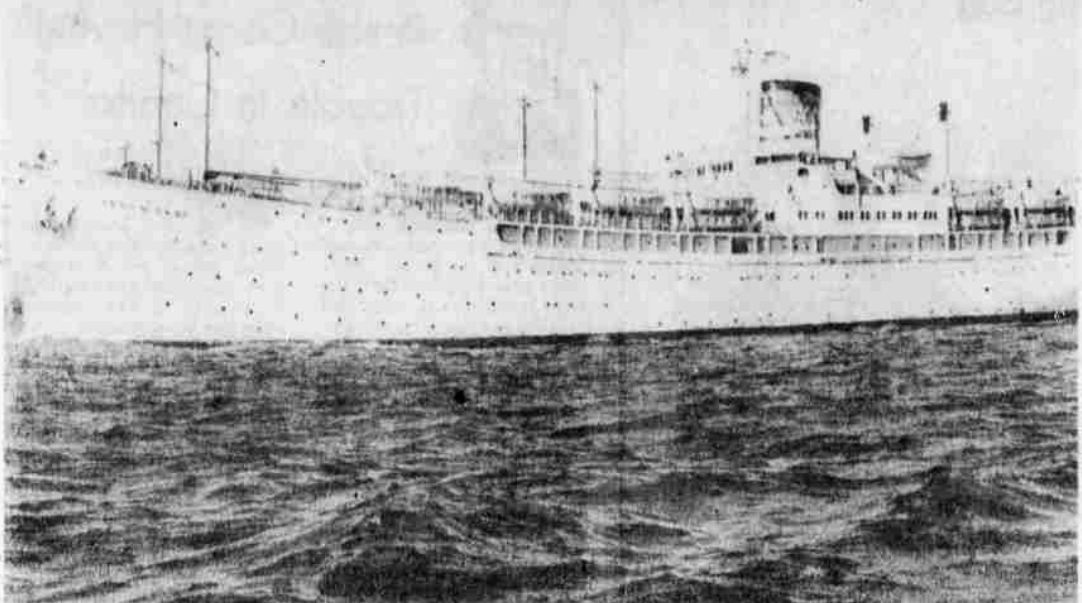

Formal Education Goes On Sea Cruise

NEW YORK (UPI)—A sea-going university with most of the educational advantages of land-based colleges and all of the pleasures of an ocean cruise will sail from New York this fall on its maiden voyage around the world.

The coed school is called the University of the Seven Seas. Its campus is the passenger liner "Seven Seas," a trim 428-foot vessel owned by the Holland-America Line.

Backers of the university are hoping for an enrollment of 500 students when the "Seven Seas" departs.

The executive director is Dr. E. Ray Nichols Jr., former chairman of the Department of Speech

and Drama at Whittier, Calif. College.

Some facts and figures about the new university:

Tuition: A basic fee of \$400 per student each semester, plus passage costs ranging from \$1,500 for dormitory space on "C" Deck to \$1,900 for two or four berth staterooms on "A" and "B" decks. The passage fees include meals.

Admission: Any student is eligible to apply, regardless of race or religion, who has maintained at least a "C" average in college or a "B" average in high school.

Curriculum: Liberal arts, with courses in almost all regular college subjects, including history, economics, English, foreign languages, sociology, astronomy and philosophy.

Faculty: Thirty-five members, including a dean of men and a dean of women. Most of the faculty are professors and assistant professors on sabbatical leaves from their colleges and universities.

The University of the Seven Seas has entered into an agreement with Springfield, Mass., College under which credits between the two institutions will be interchangeable. Nichols said 12 other colleges and universities have agreed to accept credits earned aboard ship.

"We hope to reach credit agreements with several other schools before sailing time," Nichols said.

The maiden voyage, Nichols said, will include stops at Lisbon, Barcelona, Cannes, Rome, Naples, Beirut, Alexandria, Port Said, Suez, Bombay, Singapore, Bangkok, Hong Kong, Yokohama and

Honolulu. The ship is scheduled to dock at San Diego, Calif., on Feb. 8, 1964 — the end of the first semester.

The spring semester will begin on Feb. 11 when the Seven Seas leaves for a 120-day voyage with stops at Honolulu, Yokohama, Hong Kong, Manila, Singapore, Rangoon, Madras, Colombo, Capetown, Buenos Aires, Montevideo, Cartagena, Kingston and finally to New York on June 9.

At each stop, Nichols said, students will be taken on field trips to acquaint them with the people and problems of foreign lands.

"Each student," he said, "will thus be an informal ambassador of his home country." About 40 days will be spent in port during each semester.

Nichols added that the field trips will include meetings and discussions "with important political figures and prominent individuals." He said one such meeting has already been set up with President Sukarno of Indonesia.

Degrees will not be awarded, but transcripts of records will be sent to colleges or universities for credit.

Negros Hit McNamara's GI Orders

An order by Defense Secretary Robert McNamara that uniformed troops must not participate in racial demonstrations has been sharply challenged by integration organizations.

Caught up in the controversy is the little town of Havelock which lies outside the main entrance gate to the Cherry Point Marine Air Station in the flatlands of eastern North Carolina.

Racial groups have leveled discrimination charges against the "public accommodations" of the town which derives much of its income from the 2,600 men of Cherry Point, 600 of whom are Negroes.

Floyd McKissick, a Durham, N.C., lawyer who is national executive director of the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE) and an attorney for the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), announced that McNamara will be asked this week to declare Havelock off limits to Marines unless the places used by the service men are desegregated.

Clubs, Cafes Segregated
He said he based his information that at least 17 night clubs and cafes and three theaters in the town were segregated on reports from a Marine who had just transferred home from duty in Japan.

A spokesman at Cherry Point, home of the 2nd Marine Air Wing, said the base would adhere strictly to a July 16 directive by McNamara and that "we will very definitely discourage participation in demonstrations."

In that directive, the defense secretary said that military personnel "may not under any circumstances" participate in racial demonstrations during duty hours while they were in uniform, while on military reservations, when their participation breaks a civilian law or when violence is reasonably likely to result from a demonstration in which they were participating.

The Besalou Elephants are making their 1963 coast-to-coast tour in first class accommodations. They share a mobile home that is heated in winter and air-conditioned in summer. There are private accommodations for their grooms, too, so that these pachyderm aristocrats can have 24-hour room service whether on the move or giving their twice daily circus performances. This proboscidian palace car cost nearly \$36,000.

The Besalou Elephants are featured along with more than two score of international circus favorites in the 1963 edition of Polack Brothers Circus.

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Anti-Federation Action Planned By Indonesians

JAKARTA, Indonesia (UPI)—he prays "the day will not come when Malaysia and Indonesia clash with each other." Indonesia announced today it will hold four days of naval maneuvers in the waters off Malaya and Borneo under its policy of "confrontation" against the proposed Malaysia Federation.

In London Sunday, Malayan Premier Tengku Abdul Rahman, one of the key figures in bringing together the federation, said he would use arms to defend Malaysia if anyone, including Indonesia, threatens its integrity.

Rahman said Indonesian President Sukarno has "clearly declared he wants to oppose this federation by all means" but said

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
