State Asks Route Review

SALEM (UPI) — Two state agencies have asked the Civil Aeronautics Board to review its order which would have eliminated West Coast Airlines service in Salem, Lakeview and Burns.

The petition to the CAB was sent by Public Utility Commissioner Jonel C. Hill and the State Board of Aeronautics.

The CAB order on West Coast's operations was scheduled to go into effect next week, but the petitions from the state agencies and several Oregon cities will delay its implementation.

The petition filed by the state agencies argues that the airline has never instituted a usable commuter service between Ontario, Baker, Pendleton and Portland.

It points out the order doesn't direct the airline to institute service between Boise, Idaho, and Portland with Burns, Bend and Salem as intermediate points.

It also questions the CAB's policy and discretion in recommending the deletion of Lakeview as a service point in light of inferior Lakeview - Portland service that has been offered and lack of service to Reno, Nev.

Army Offers Pilot Course

Keeping pace with their ever-expanding air mission, the U.S. Army is now offering high school graduates direct enlistments for aviation pilot training, according to an announcement made by Sgt. M. W. Buess, local Army recruiter.

This is the latest addition to the Army's "Choice Not Chance" enlistment program which offers young men and women their choice of hundreds of career opportunities—guaranteed in writing before they enlist.

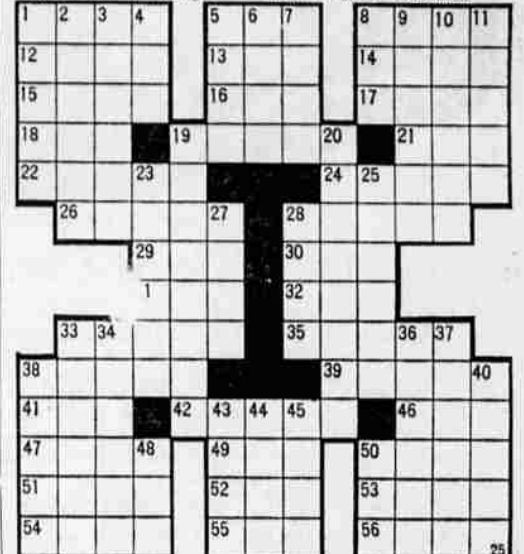
Under the aviation option, high school graduates may apply for pilot training in helicopters or conventional aircraft and a commission as a warrant officer, if they are a United States citizen, more than 18 and less than 30 years of age, able to pass comprehensive mental and physical examinations, between five feet four inches and six feet four inches in height, under 200 pounds in weight, and willing to enlist for two years, and agree to accept an appointment as a warrant officer.

Sergeant Buess said that qualified candidates will receive a written guarantee, before enlisting, insuring Army pilot training upon successful completion of eight weeks basic training.

Distraught Mother Held In Killing Of Husband

BEDFORD, Ind. (UPI) — "I think God will forgive me for what I have done," the attractive 42-year-old mother said.

Mrs. Geneva Brewer was held today on murder charges after she admitted she shot her husband 13 times at a roadside park near here.

Her 13-year-old son, Phillip, told police he saw his mother kill his father, Elsworth, 43.

The family had wandered about Indiana in an old station wagon for six months, with Brewer working for two or three days at a time as a carpenter, then quitting and moving on.

Phillips said he last went to school in Centerville, Ind. The boy told officers his parents had been arguing for about four hours. They had spent the night in an abandoned house near Evansville.

As the boy's father fell, his feet went under the car. David Kinsel, Columbus, Ind., was driving by and saw Mrs. Brewer pull the body out from under the car.

Kinsel stopped. As he came up, he said, Mrs. Brewer turned and fired two more shots into her husband's head then waved the gun at him and threatened to kill him.

Kinsel fled and summoned authorities who arrested the woman without resistance.

She told Lawrence County authorities that in the 18 years she and her husband were married, they never had any home life. She said her husband always wanted to wander.

"It's been building up in me for a long time. I took it as long as I could," she said.
