Inattention Is Sometimes Good

Sometimes it pays to keep your eyes and ears open, but once in a while you will do better by being partially unconscious during the bidding.

West did not hear North's opening club bid and he thought that his partner had opened one spade and South had stuck in an overcall. Even so West had no clear cut bid, but he decided to double and hope for the best and the best sure happened.

West opened the four of spades and South decided to play dummy's jack. East won with the king and while East knew he could give his partner an immediate ruff, East was looking for better things. He did not know exactly what was going on, but he assumed that his partner had heard the opening bid and East led the three of hearts.

South won and played the eight of clubs. West thought a while and decided to rise with the a.c. Then West led the queen of hearts and South took his second high heart. Now South led a heart and ruffed in dummy, whereupon the roof fell on him. East overruled with the nine and led a spade for West to ruff. West led a trump right back. As far as he knew his partner had opened the bidding and was clearly marked with good diamonds.

East took the trick with the king and gave his partner another spade ruff. This left poor South down one and he still had to lose a heart and a trump for an 800-point loss.

A—Bid four no-trump! If your partner holds an ace you want to play the hand at six. If he doesn't hold an ace the chances are that you would be forced to five hearts in any event.

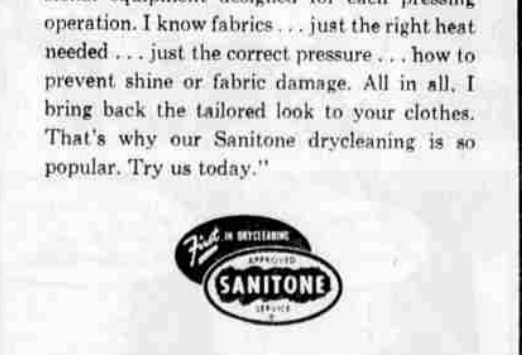

Army Sets Special Move

WASHINGTON (UPI)—The Defense Department is planning to fly an entire Army division—about 15,000 troops—to Germany later this year in a dramatic demonstration of its jet age ability to "get there first with the most."

A major implication of the mass move is that it may point the way for America to reduce its permanent garrison in Germany at some future time and rely on high-speed air lifts for quick reinforcement in emergencies.

Actress Faces Drug Charge

VAN VUYS, Calif. (UPI) — Marie (The Body) McDonald, 40, faces sentencing Aug. 23 for forging two prescriptions to obtain the pain-killing drug percodan.

The blonde actress was released on \$325 bail Friday by Municipal Judge Francis Cochran after she pleaded guilty to the charges, which carry a maximum penalty of one to six years in state prison.

Miss McDonald, who has had a stormy career, was booked and fingerprinted at city prison on a complaint filed by B. H. Blanchard, a state narcotics agent.

Blanchard charged that Miss McDonald obtained percodan on two occasions, June 27 at an Enigma pharmacy and July 2 at a Sherman Oaks drugstore.

Miss McDonald sought an immediate preliminary hearing, promptly waived it and pleaded guilty.

Blanchard said Miss McDonald was traced through her automobile license plate number after Sherman Oaks pharmacist Darrell M. Levine became suspicious of her.
