

Spokane Continues Winning Ways In Downing Oklahoma City Chiefs, 4-2

The scoreboard looked more like it was for football than baseball by the time they got through Tuesday night at Salt Lake City. San Diego grabbed a 7-0 lead, but somehow managed to wind up on the short end of a 15-12 count at game's end. Salt Lake had a pair of six-run innings and outthrew the Padres, 17-15.
Things were a bit turner elsewhere in the Pacific Coast League. Spokane disposed of Oklahoma City, 4-2, in a game that seemed like a convention of former Los Angeles Dodgers.
This increased Spokane's Northern Division lead to 7½ games since Tacoma fell before Portland 8-5. Meanwhile, Dallas-Ft. Worth disposed of Denver, 6-3, behind young Marv Mecklenburg to move 1½ games up on Oklahoma City in the Southern Division. Seattle nudged Hawaii 5-4 in a struggle of also-rans.
Homer by Bill Cowan, Curt Jensen, and Bob Will helped Salt Lake outlast San Diego, Jack Warner, who arrived in Salt Lake city after the game had begun, picked up the win in relief and is now 4-1. He had been sent to the Chicago Cubs and was shuffled back yesterday. Ted Willis, third of four Padre hurlers, took the loss and is now 9-8.
Mel Queen, Bobby Klaus and Deron Johnson had big nights for the Padres, but San Diego still lost to Salt Lake for the 14th in 17 meetings this season.
Spokane got to ex-Dodger Jim Golden for eight hits in four innings while piling up a 3-0 lead. Ex-Dodger Phil Ortega meanwhile retired 14 straight men and Wednesday, July 31, 1963

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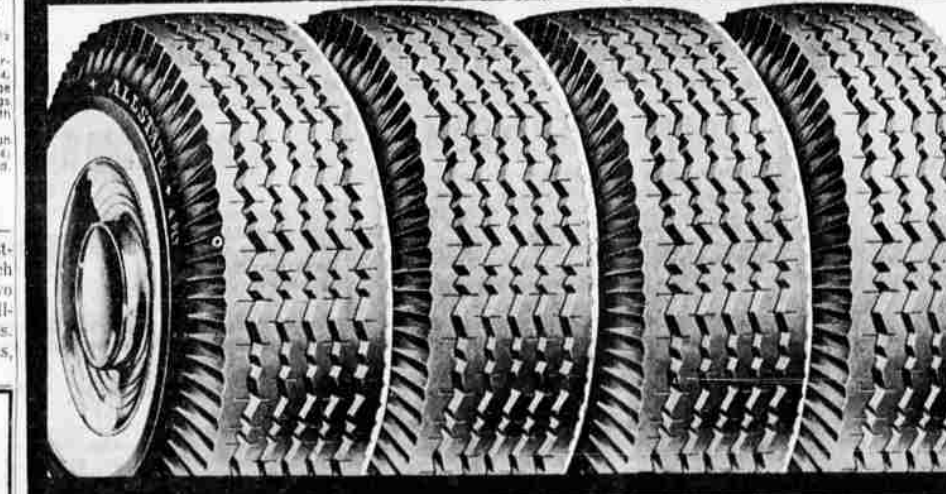
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
