

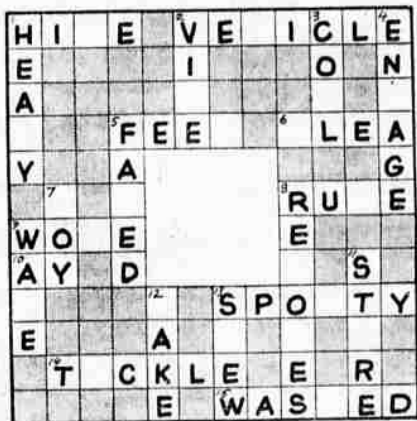

SOME QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT THE RELIABILITY OF VITAMIN PRODUCTS...

- Q. Are all vitamins alike?**
A. No. There are differences in their chemical composition and in their degrees of value in human nutrition. In finished vitamin products, there may be differences in quality. Quality is dependent on purity of ingredients, manufacturing skill, and continuous control testing and vitamin assays from raw materials through every stage of manufacture to the finished product.
- Q. Are vitamin products guaranteed by the Government?**
A. No. The Government does have regulations concerning food, drug and cosmetic products, including vitamin products, but the Government does not guarantee any vitamin product.
- Q. Does the Government check all vitamins?**
A. Government inspectors do check vitamins, but not all. It would be impossible for them to open every package sent through the mail, to check every vitamin sold door-to-door, or to open and test all vitamin packages in stores.
- Q. Are all vitamins uniformly stable?**
A. No. Some are acid, some alkaline. When combined in formulas, certain vitamins destroy others, unless the manufacturer has the experience and high degree of skill necessary to separate these vitamins or minerals and to protect one from the other.
- Q. Are so-called "bargain" vitamins worth buying?**
A. We do not recommend such products. We suggest that before you take a chance with your money or your health that you get answers to these questions: What do you know about the reliability of the manufacturer or the name on the label? Is the formula medically approved? Does the formula have enough of the essential vitamins, or is it filled with cheap non-essential ingredients? Would your doctor prescribe it?
- Q. What is the best assurance on a vitamin product?**
A. The name on the label. You cannot get a better assurance than the name of a company that makes the drugs your doctor prescribes for your family.
