

COOL CANTALOUPE SALAD

Chill California cantaloupe wedges and sprinkle with lemon juice and salt. Serve on lettuce and dollop with a mixture of grated Cheddar cheese, chopped onion and parsley, dairy sour cream, seasoned salt and pepper and a dash of Tabasco. Garnish with tomato wedges.

CURRIED CLINGS

For a light dessert reminiscent of the Far East, drain the syrup from a 1 lb., 13 oz. can of cling peach halves. Simmer syrup with one teaspoon of curry powder about five minutes. Pour over peaches; chill well. Serve peach halves with curried syrup; sprinkle with coconut.

AVOCADO FRANKS

Hot dog! Mash a California avocado and add a little lemon juice, chopped onion, salt and pepper for a flavorsome spread for frankfurters.

FRESH BARTLETT SEASON

August and September are peak months for juicy fresh California Bartlett pears.

SANDWICH TIME-LY TIPS

Baker's Dozen . . . August, time of heat waves and appetite doldrums, is Sandwich Month.

Sandwiches, of course, need not be elaborate—in hot weather, who wants to work?—but they should be attractive to tempt hot weather palates. To keep costs within your budget, plan sandwiches around the July and August Plentiful Foods — salad

vegetables, dairy products, turkey, tuna and peanut butter. According to USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, supplies of these are larger than they were last year.

Need some ideas? Take your pick from a baker's dozen. Some are cold and others hot. Some are hearty; others are not. Spoon creamed chicken, turkey or seafood over toast. Cover with Swiss or American cheese slices;

dust with paprika and brown under broiler.

Spread peanut butter, sprinkled with crumbled bacon, between slices of whole wheat bread. Dip in mixture of beaten egg and milk. Grill on both sides until brown.

Heat meaty spaghetti sauce and spread on toasted bun halves. Top with grated Parmesan cheese.

Cover rye bread slices with hot sliced ham. Spoon on hot baked beans and top with chili sauce.

Arrange hard cooked egg slices or halves on whole wheat toast. Cover with warm cheese sauce; sprinkle with chopped parsley. Serve with sausage links.

Cut slices from tops of hard rolls; scoop out to form shells. Brush shells with melted butter and toast in oven. Fill with creamed mushrooms, peas, and chicken, crab, dried beef or tuna. Garnish with green pepper rings.

Toast sour dough bread slices on one side. Cover untoasted side with Swiss cheese slices; place under broiler to melt cheese. Top with scrambled eggs and bacon.

Tuna salad—tuna blended with

salad dressing, chopped celery, pickle relish and capers—lettuce and tomato slices between split submarine rolls.

Soften cream cheese and mix with salad dressing. Blend in diced cucumber and green pepper; spread on cracked wheat bread slices. Use crisp ras spinach leaves instead of lettuce.

Club sandwich. First filling: Shrimp or crab salad with lettuce and tomato slices. Second filling: Egg salad with lettuce and cucumber slices. White, whole wheat or cracked wheat bread—or a combination.

Spread rye bread with mustard dressing; add luncheon meat, sliced tomatoes, sliced onion and green pepper rings.

Open — face sandwich: Sliced boiled ham on white bread, then sliced turkey and a one-inch slice

of head lettuce. Spoon on thou-

ter; add lettuce, then thinly sliced medium or rare roast beef, with slivered cheddar cheese and smoked chipped beef or corned beef. Pass mustard or horserad-
