Coolers Hint Exotic Flavor

The more sizzling the day, the more welcome a tall tinkling cooler. Try the three given here. They are different enough to be appealing, cool enough to refresh.

TAFFY MINT TWIST
(1 serving)
Juice of 1 lemon
2 tablespoons unsifted molasses
Ginger ale
Shaved ice
Mint leaves
Combine lemon juice and molasses. Pour over shaved ice in tall glass. Fill to top with ginger ale. Garnish with mint leaves.

BANANA TAFFY MILK
(1 serving)
1/2 ripe medium banana, mashed
1 teaspoon instant coffee, optional
1 tablespoon unsifted molasses
Pinch salt
Milk
Combine mashed banana, instant coffee, unsifted molasses and salt in a tall glass. Fill to top with milk; stir. If desired, sprinkle with nutmeg.

FRESH GRAPE AND LEMON ICE CUP
(6 servings)
3 cups fresh green seedless grapes
3/4 cup fresh orange juice
6 single scoops lemon ice or sherbet
Place 1/2 cup grapes in each of 6 sherbet glasses. Pour over each 2 tablespoons fresh orange juice. Top with fresh lemon dessert. Serve as appetizer or dessert course.

Food Hints

Make your own "nibble food" by toasting salted mixed nuts in olive oil seasoned with garlic powder and crushed chili peppers. Cook over medium heat in heavy skillet, stirring constantly, for about 10 minutes. Remove nuts, drain, and sprinkle with chili powder before serving.

Cornd beef gets its name from the corn-sized pieces of salt used at one time to preserve it. Now beef is "corned" by soaking it in brine.

For a stimulating facial massage, mix salt and olive oil in equal proportions and gently rub over face and throat with long upward strokes.

Use garlic chips for slow release of flavor in marinades in which meats will cook for several hours or overnight.

If your recipe calls for rubbing dry herbs on a roast, use cracked instead of whole bay leaves. They are easier to handle.

NEW COMBINATION IN SALAD
Avocado-Potato Salad

From California, Mrs. D. F. of El Centro writes that her combination salad of potatoes and avocado is always popular at church suppers. We tried it last night at home. Now we know why it is popular.
The extra flavors of crisp bacon, cucumber, pimiento, onion and celery spark the combination of avocado and potatoes. But why wait for Mrs. D. F.'s church supper? How about tonight? Serve with cold meats, heated rolls. A cup of hot clear soup might be welcome as the first course.

AVOCADO POTATO SALAD (6 to 8 servings)
4 slices crisp bacon, crumbled
1 cup sliced celery (and a few minced leaves)
1/2 cup chopped onion
3 cups cubed cooked potatoes
1 can (2 oz.) sliced pimiento
1 can chopped cucumber
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
2 to 3 teaspoons vinegar
1 avocado
1/2 cup Italian or French dressing
Combine all ingredients except avocado and dressing. Cut avocado lengthwise into halves; remove seed and skin. Slice enough avocado for garnish; dip into dressing, then drain. Cube remaining avocado; add to salad with remaining dressing. Toss lightly. Garnish with avocado slices. Chill and serve.
