

Henley High Plans Remain Unchanged

The county school district's main unchanged in the event of plans for a new high school at reorganization of the Klamath the 20-acre Henley site will re-county school areas into two sep-

arate districts. Cliff Robinson, county district school superintendent, indicated Thursday.

The architect firm of Morrison, Howard and Starbuck was instructed to plan a building that will ultimately fit the needs of 1,200 students. Preliminary plans indicate the building will be constructed from serial levy monies in five separate phases. The total cost was estimated at \$1,500,000.

If the entire county was reorganized into a metro-rural two district set-up would there still be a need for a 1,200-student building at Henley, Robinson was asked.

"The need wouldn't be there right away, but we would proceed according to plan and build as needed until the final 1,200-student goal is reached," the superintendent said.

The first construction phase calls for a 25,000 square foot building that will accommodate 300 students. The next phase involves a 26,000 square foot addition with a total student capacity of 500. These two units should be thought of as additions to the present Henley High since students in the new building will be still taking some classes in the old school.

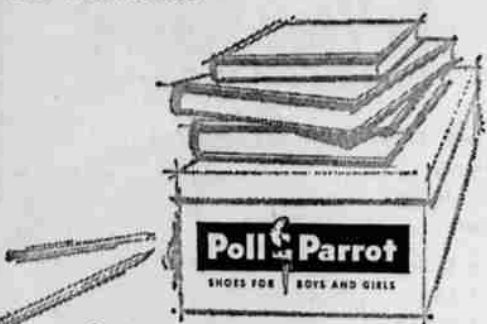
Additions of five classrooms, two music rooms, a library, shop and administration unit will come during phase two. A principal and administrative staff will be hired at this point.

The boys' gym facilities, a cafeteria, four more classrooms, two new labs, another homemaker unit and more administration offices will be added in phase three and the school will be a self-contained unit for the first time.

The last two phases just continue the expansion of rooms and other facilities to meet the needs of a greater number of students.

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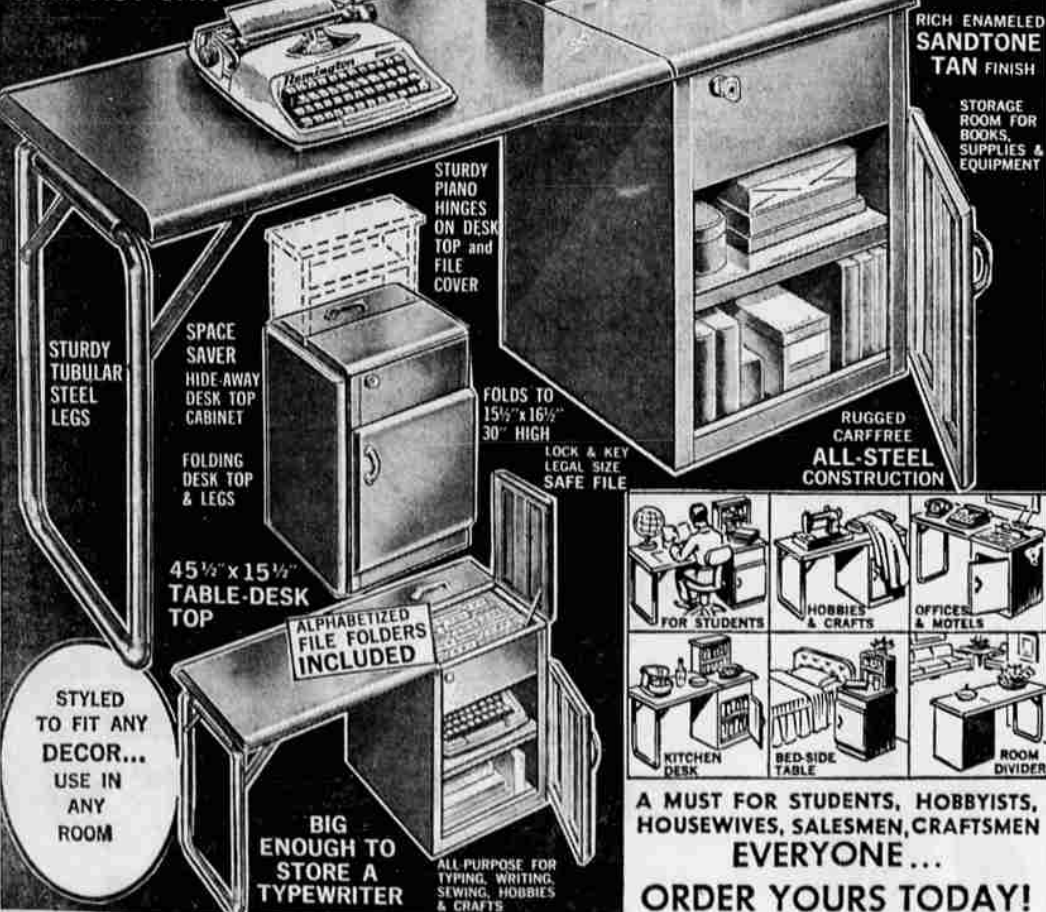

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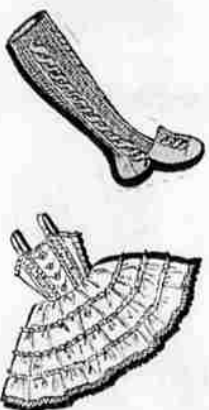
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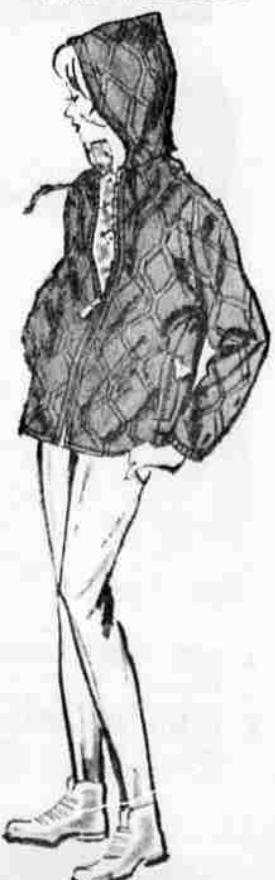
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
