Gain Offsets Likely Loss

Here is a hand from Marshall Miles' new book, "All Fifty-two Cards." The East-West hands are not shown because declarer should be able to plan his play without seeing any of them.

The bidding is rather involved and most people would read six hearts without quite so much formality. The contract also appears to be a cinch. South wins the opening diamond with his ace and leads a heart. West shows out and South finds that he has an unexpected trump loser. There also is a diamond loser and South looks around to see if he can do anything about that.

It doesn't take a long look. South cashes dummy's two high trumps and comes to his own hand with a club. Then he leads a spade and finesse dummy's queen. If the finesse works he can get rid of his losing diamond, if the finesse loses he will go down two instead of one. Certainly he can afford to risk this small extra loss against the possible slam and he takes the gamble.

Another interesting question with this hand is, "What should South do against a spade opening?"

The answer is that he should finesse. This will cost him his contract only if West has opened a singleton spade and also holds the queen of hearts. It gains a trick any time West holds the spade king and in the event that East has all three trumps this trick will be most important.
