VERSATILITY OF LAMB

(Continued from 1-B)

least 2 hours. Drain off water and with both hands blend in ground lamb. Add onion, salt, pepper, and cinnamon. Mix thoroughly. May be served raw or baked.

To bake: pat into baking pan and smooth with cold water. Cut into diamond shaped pieces. Cut up 1/4 pound butter and place over top. Bake in 350 degree oven until top shows a faint brown color.

Served raw: place on platter and garnish with parsley and sliced onions. Chill a few hours before serving.

LAMB EGGPLANT CASSEROLE

2 eggplants
3 cups ground lamb
tomato sauce
salt and pepper
1 clove garlic
2 tbs. parsley chopped fine
Cut eggplant in 1/2 inch slices. Cover bottom of skillet with oil and heat. Brown each side in hot oil or until tender. Line bottom of baking dish with browned eggplant and salt and pepper it. Brown ground lamb and finely

chopped clove of garlic. Drain off fat. Spread ground lamb over eggplant in casserole and place remaining fried eggplant over meat. Pour tomato sauce over this, barely covering eggplant and meat. Sprinkle chopped parsley over top. Bake in 300 degree oven 1 1/2 hours. Delicious served with Rice Pilaf.

HONEY MUSTARD LEG ROAST

1 five pound leg of lamb
1/2 cup prepared mustard
1/2 cup honey
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
1/2 teaspoon rosemary

Place lamb on rack in shallow roasting pan. Bake in a low oven (325) two hours. Combine mustard, honey, salt, pepper and crumble in rosemary. Pour over lamb. Bake 1 to 2 hours or until meat thermometer registers 175-180 (depending upon desired degree of doneness). Garnish with lemon cups filled with mint jelly, maraschino cherries, and mint leaves.

PATIO SALAD

Pickle-shrimp patio salad is a good dish for a summer's day. Combine 3 cups of cold cooked rice, with 2 cups of cooked, cleaned shrimp, 2-3 cup of drained sweet mixed pickles, 1 crushed bay leaf and 1/2 teaspoon of savory. Add 1 1/2 teaspoons of salt, 1/4 cup of salad oil, 2 tablespoons of vinegar, 1 teaspoon of sugar, 2 tablespoons of sweet pickle liquid and 1/4 teaspoon of pepper. Toss well. Serve chilled. Serves 4.

PICNIC BROILS

Pack individual picnic suppers in foil to be broiled on an outdoor grill. Sliced 4 small cooked potatoes and arrange slices in a row on narrow end of each of 4 slices (6 by 4 by 3/4 inch) of cooked ham. Mix together 1 tablespoon each of salad oil and sweet pickle liquid and 1/2 teaspoon of caraway seed. Drizzle over potatoes. Top each potato layer with 2 tablespoons of sweet fresh cucumber pickles, drained. Roll as for Jelly roll. Wrap securely in aluminum foil. Broil or cook on grill 3 to 5 minutes.

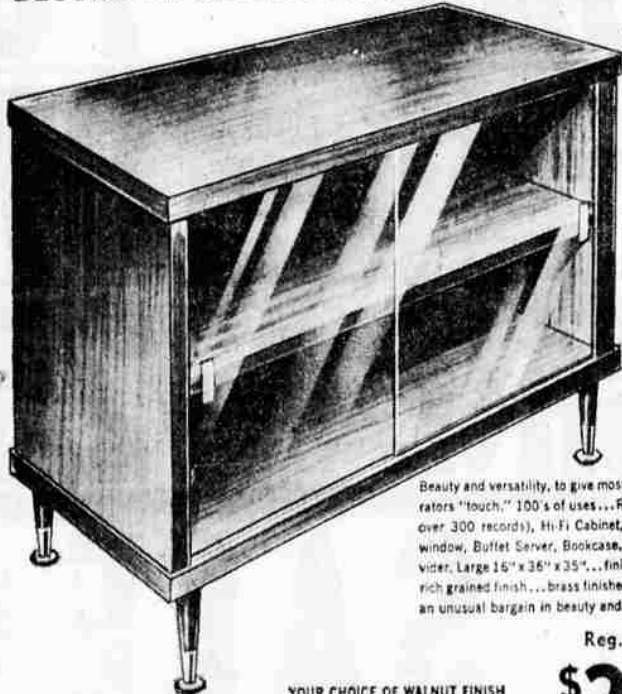
