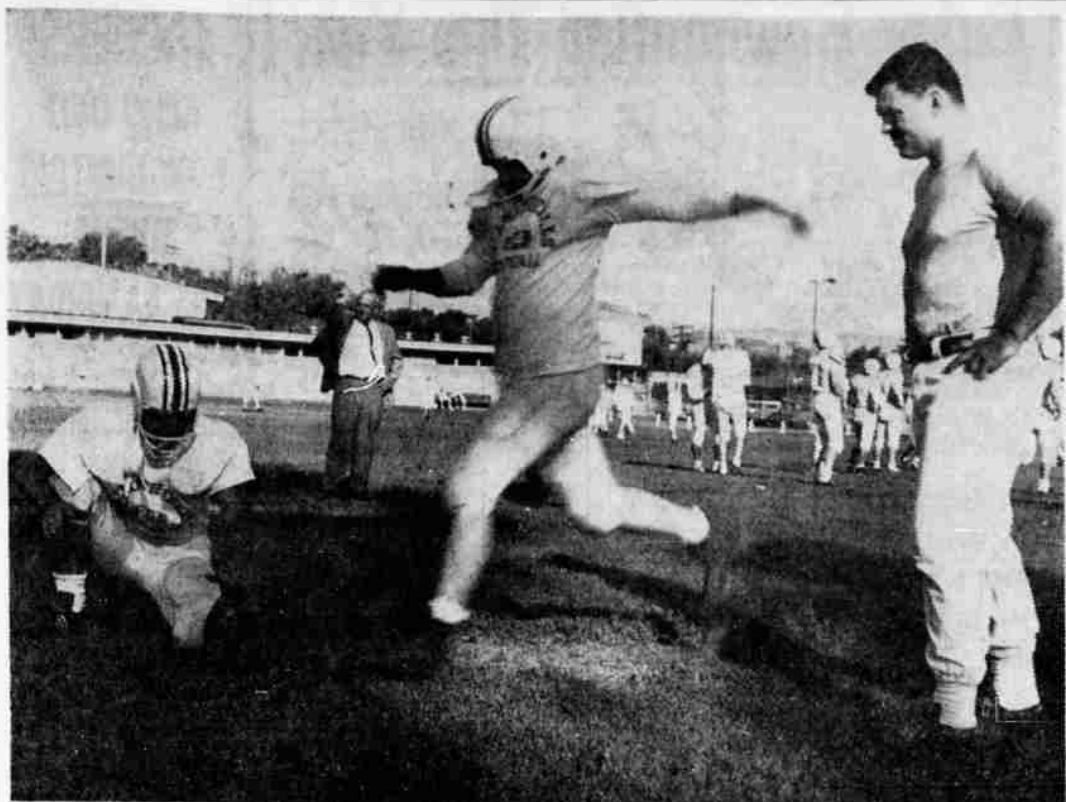

The Pelicans have been going through a number of fundamentals, conditioning drills and some pass offense and defensive tactics. Much of the same will continue today before the scrimmage tomorrow. Next Tuesday will be the last of the two-day sessions. School officially begins next Wednesday.
