

Forest Service Warns Of Trucks And Water

LAKEVIEW — A warning is being given by the Forest Service to look out for logging traffic on the Fishlake road in the Bly ranger district. Campers are cautioned again that spring water at the upper end of Lottion Reservoir should be boiled before drinking.

Fishing is poor in the South Fork of Sprague River, but there is no report for other streams or reservoirs. Fire danger is extreme in lower elevations where grass is mature.

There is increased log hauling on Dog Lake Road 4017 and Road 575 West, toward Bly. In the Drews Valley ranger district, motorists are urged to use turnouts when meeting loaded trucks. Fishing success has slowed and fish from Cottonwood taste of algae. With high fire danger, all forest users are asked to be extra careful with camp fires and smoking.

All main roads on the Paisley district are dusty and rough; all trails can be used but there is fallen timber. Fishing is poor on the Chewaucan River; fair on the Sprague and Sycan rivers. Camp-

bell and Deadhorse lakes have been good. Fire danger is still high and shovels, buckets, and axes are still required. Caution should be taken in chest grass and blowdown areas.

A watch for logging traffic is cautioned on the Benny Creek and Forest truck roads of the Silver Lake district. It is recommended that campers bring their own drinking water if camping at Silver Creek Marsh or East Bay campground. Good success is reported in trolling or still fishing at Thompson Reservoir. Fishermen report taste from algae.

Archery hunting was slow over the weekend on the Warner district; fishing was fair. Fire danger is high; no power saws are allowed on the North Warner area during weekends or holidays.

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THE DOCTOR SAYS Color Or Not, Dreams Important

Do you dream in black and white or, gorgeous colors? Scientific observers at the University of Chicago sleep laboratories have found that you may do either, and that they can control this and other aspects of dreaming by giving their subjects certain hormones.

When they gave pituitary extract, the subjects had pleasant dreams that were easily remembered and came complete with a full range of color. When they gave adrenal extract the dreams were frightening, hard to remember, and colorless.

To another question: Do animals talk in our dreams? I can give a personal answer. Animals that I have enjoyed as pets do talk, and I believe that this indicates that anything that we are capable of imagining may appear to us as a reality when we dream.

The blind have also been found to dream. The only difference is that if they were born blind they dream only of the world as they know it. In their dreams they hear, touch, taste, and smell but have no visual images.

In those who become blind after their visual sense has been well developed, visual images become less and less a part of their dreams as time goes on.

One of the important discoveries that has been made about dreaming is that it appears to be not only inevitable, but also a necessary accompaniment of sleep. When sleeping subjects were awakened every time rapid eye movements indicated that they were starting to dream, it was

possible to insure that they had a truly dreamless night.

This was found to increase the number of times the subject would start to dream as though the mind was not going to take these interruptions without a protest.

When this prevention of dreaming was persisted in for several nights the subjects became edgy, jittery, and had great difficulty concentrating.

At this point they were allowed to dream uninterrupted. The length of time spent in dreaming was found to be twice what it had normally been. This was true for several nights.

Other subjects were awakened the same number of times as the first group had been, but at times when they were not dreaming. They did not become upset and, when allowed to sleep without interruption, the length of their dreams was not increased.

This would seem to indicate that dreaming, in some way not yet known, helps us to maintain our balance and get the most good from our sleep.
