

Dogs Perform Saturday

The Klamath Dog Fanciers' 14th Annual All Breed Dog Show opens with a record entry of 711 canines, 9 a.m. tomorrow, at the Klamath County Fairgrounds Pavilion Building.

Awards will go to dogs judged best in show, best of group and best of breeds, although in the latter case each event must number at least five entrants before prizes will be awarded.

Aug. 17 was the last day that dog owners could enter their pets in the competitions.

Refreshments will be available during the one-day show. Judges for this year's event include Dr. A. A. Mitten, Rock Hall, Md.; Anton B. Korbel, Hillsborough, Calif.; and Maurice L. Baker, Minneapolis, Minn.

K. Blackman Ends Job In Klamath

Kenneth R. Blackman today ends a two-year term as Klamath city-county planning consultant.

Blackman Tuesday will move his wife and two children to Eureka, Calif., where he has accepted a post as city planning director. He was hired by the Eureka City Council Aug. 6.

Klamath Falls will be without a planning consultant for at least two weeks. Several candidates for the position are currently being interviewed by the University of Oregon, which provides planning consultants for Oregon cities and counties.

A slate of acceptable candidates will be presented to city and county officials and a choice will be made for Blackman's replacement within a month.

Deer Season Will Open For Archers

The deer hunting season for archers opens in the Klamath Unit beginning at dawn tomorrow, but hunters are reminded that some of the public lands in the unit are closed to trespass.

George Wardell, supervisor of the Klamath Forest Protective Association, said today.

Wardell referred in particular to an area along the Green Springs highway which has been closed to public access due to extremely hazardous road conditions.

The area off-limits to hunters extends from the Klamath River west to Jenny Creek and then from the California-Oregon boundary north to Buck Lake. Also closed is the Aspen Lake and Doak Mountain regions, Wardell said.

The penalty for anyone found trespassing on KFPFA closures is a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100, or not less than two days nor more than 60 days in the county jail, or both.

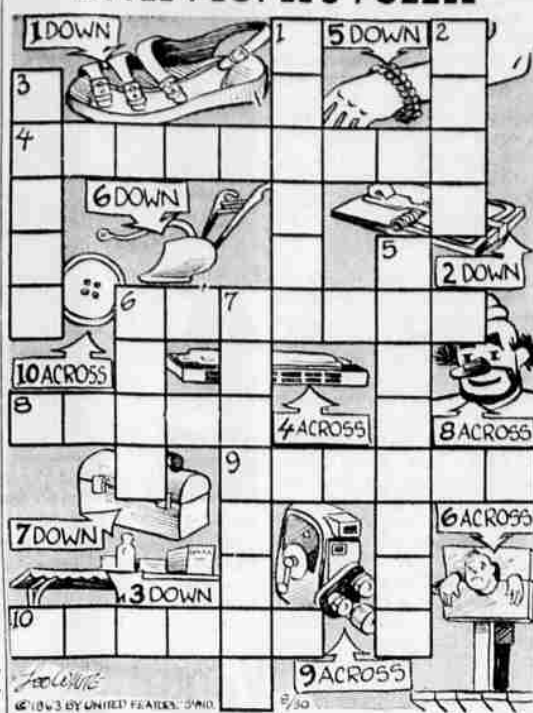
