

Late Summer Dates Chosen For Nuptial Ceremonies

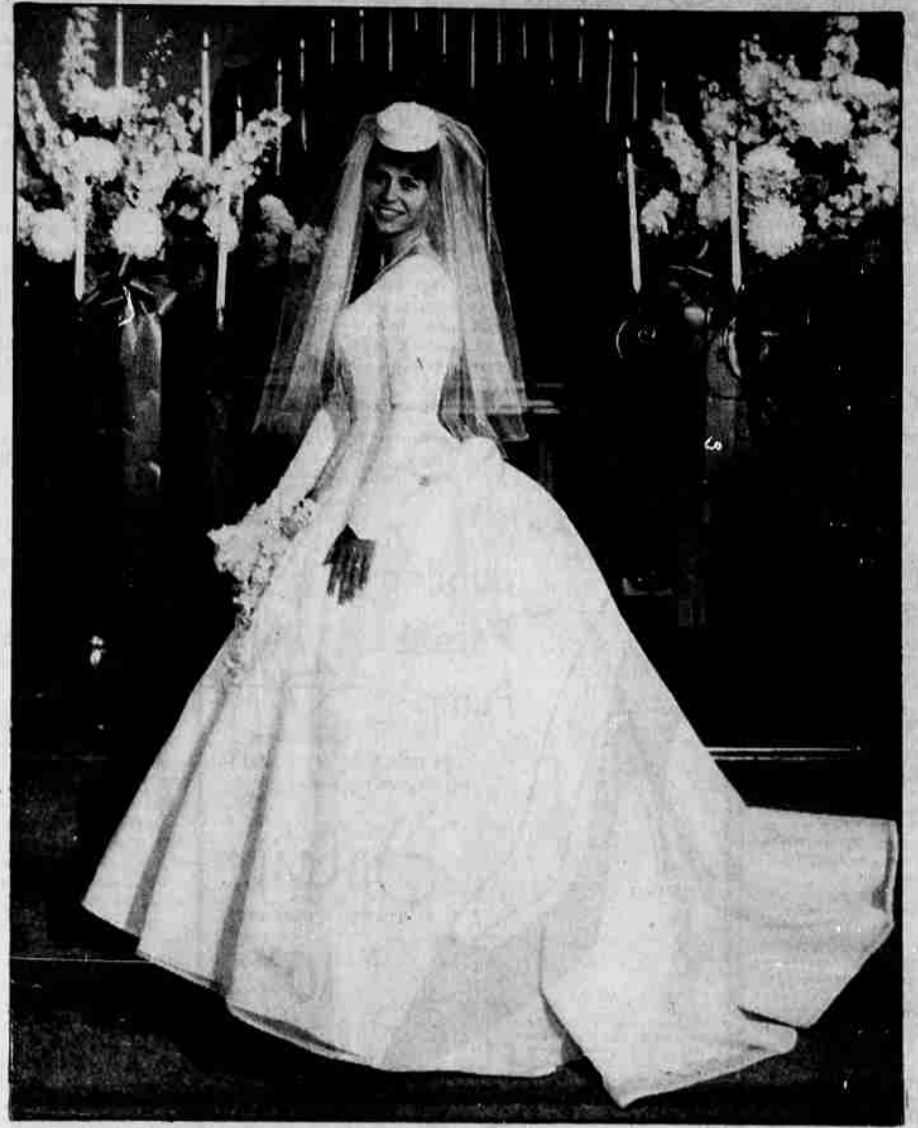
