Stayman Explained

During the war years George Rapee and Sam Stayman of New York developed a system of responding to opening no-trumps in which the two club response to the opening no-trump was an artificial forcing bid. Stayman's name was attached to the convention and today every expert in the world uses it in some form or other.

The uses diverge tremendously, but they all go under the general name of Stayman so I will call mine Jacoby-Stayman. Of course Jacoby-Stayman fits perfectly with the Jacoby transfer bid, but whether or not you use the transfer bid you should use Jacoby-Stayman.

The bidding shown in the box would be that of any pair using any version of Stayman. The hand shows why all experts use the convention.

Without the artificial club North would probably respond three no-trump and South would have no play for the contract. The diamond opening would establish three diamond tricks and East and West would each collect a trick with an ace.

The two club response is artificial and specifically asks the opening bidder to show a four card major suit if he has one. South has four spades and shows it whereupon North bids four spades. There is no defense against four spades. East and West can make their two aces, but they can only add one diamond trick.

Garrison To Solicit Educators

(Editor's Note—This is the sixth in a series of personality sketches on the 13 persons who head the United Fund campaign in Klamath County.)

Ray L. Garrison, assistant professor of mechanical technology at Oregon Technical Institute, commands the educational division of the United Fund this year.

Employment Up In West

SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—Employment in July in the 13 western states rose 2.5 per cent over July 1962, the Federal Bureau of Labor Statistics reported.

Western regional director Max D. Kossoris said the figure compared favorably with the 2.0 per cent national increase.

Washington was the only state that did not share in the expansion. Aircraft jobs dropped by 13,500 over the year and the recently settled lumber strike took another 10,000 jobs.

Hawaii and Idaho rose 0.5 per cent while Nevada was the highest state with an 8.7 per cent increase.

The bureau also said that non-farm employment rose 21,000 from mid-June to mid-July of this year, bringing the total to 9,182,500.

In addition to Washington, Hawaii, Idaho and Nevada, the states covered in the report include Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Montana, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah and Wyoming.



THE DOCTOR SAYS Committee Head Claims Cleft Palate Cases Protest Commie-Inspired Now Being Helped

An 18-year-old girl writes that she was born with a cleft palate, which was corrected by operation when she was 6. Her problem now is that, although she can swallow normally, she has an unpleasant nasal voice. This is a common occurrence.

Cleft palate is found in about one of every 750 babies, and is the result of a failure in the embryo of the right and left halves of the palate to fuse. This may involve the soft palate alone, or both the hard and soft palates. Although in about 29 per cent of these babies there appears to be a hereditary factor, in the remaining 80 per cent no cause is found.

At Northwestern University in Chicago the Cleft Lip and Palate Institute has been working on this problem for many years. They have found that, as with many other medical problems, the best results are obtained with a team approach.

In this case the team consists of a plastic surgeon, an orthodontist (dentist who straightens the alignment of the teeth), prosthodontist (who makes dental and palatal plates), pedodontist (who has special knowledge of children's dental problems), speech therapist, and a nose and throat specialist.

The results, although truly miraculous, are not accomplished overnight. They may require 10 years to achieve.

Similar teams are now operating in many parts of the country.

Ingeniously contrived speech appliances have been fitted to many of these victims who, like my reader, have had an operation which accomplished only part of the job.

To be able to swallow is very important to a baby's development, but the ability to talk normally is equally important for the development of the adult personality.

All too often the inability to speak plainly is interpreted as a

lack of intelligence. Nothing could be further from the truth when cleft palate is the cause.

Plastic surgeons are now perfecting operations that can correct both the swallowing and the speech disorders, eliminating the need for an artificial palate. Even persons whose deformity was neglected in childhood can be helped after they attain adulthood.

It is, of course, better to correct cleft palates early in childhood. One 4-year-old child, after her palate had been repaired, was greatly helped to improve her speech through the efforts of a patient and understanding mother. This mother had her blow out candles and play games that involved blowing a feather, as well as practice pronouncing difficult words properly.

If your child has a cleft palate, this will be a handicap only if you let it be.

Q—My 4-year-old granddaughter has asthma. Would her diet have anything to do with the severity of her attacks? If so, what kind of food should be kept from her?

A—Asthma has many causes, which include inhalants such as animal dandruff, pollens, house dust and, in some persons, foods. Only by careful studies can the exact cause be determined.

If the cause is an inhalant the diet will not influence it. If it is a food, she will have to avoid any preparation that contains the offending ingredient.

The disturbance broke out when a throng of student sympathizers, angered at being barred from the committee hearing room, ignored police orders to move.

Scuffling and shouting broke out. The police moved in, and drove the demonstrators down three flights of stairs to the sidewalk. Grist screamed as they were carried out. There were shouts of "This is the way the fascists operate," and "There's more democracy in Cuba than in Washington."

Willis promised further investigations looking toward legislation to tighten laws governing travel. He said that the student trip to Cuba was a "clear violation of the law, and that the two days of hearing showed 'the difficult and changing techniques of the Communist conspiracy.'"

Termining the demonstration an "ugly episode," Willis said it was Communist-inspired, but he added that the demonstrators themselves were not Communists.

"The big boys who don't show up are the Communists," he said. When the demonstrators erupted Friday, police moved in quickly.
