

Investigation By FBI Shows Valachi's Testimony About Rackets Is Highly Accurate

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The confessions of racketeer Joseph Valachi have aided the war on organized crime but federal law enforcement officers have more weapons than that, government sources said today.

The comment followed a statement issued by Justice Department spokesman Edwin Guthman about reports that Valachi was found to be mentally ill before he began giving investigators the inside details of the national crime organization he called "Cosa Nostra."

Guthman said in his statement that "the important thing about Valachi is whether the information he has given the FBI about the highly disciplined criminal organization is accurate." He said investigation has shown that it is.

The Philadelphia Bulletin said Sunday in a copyrighted story that Dr. Harry R. Lipton, a consulting psychiatrist, found Valachi to be suffering from a persecution complex. Valachi was examined after he killed a fellow penitentiary prisoner who he thought was an emissary of the underworld out to kill him to

keep him from talking.

In Atlanta, Lipton confirmed that he examined Valachi but declined to disclose what he found.

A source told United Press International it would not be surprising if Valachi had been found to be mentally unbalanced. He said the Justice Department is not claiming Valachi is of good character and pointed out that the felon is a known "murderer, thief and trafficker in narcotics."

"You don't get information on the underworld from the P.T.A.," the source said.

The Washington Star said Sunday it was keeping a list of Cosa Nostra members and found that federal action against them was taking its toll. The Star's list

shows federal indictments are pending against 52 identified members of Cosa Nostra and another 33 have been convicted.

UPI's source emphasized that results in the move on organized crime are rooted far deeper than the Valachi information. The source said the chief value of Valachi is that he is the first syndicate member who showed a willingness to tell what he knows

publicly. The value here is in convincing the public that organized crime is not just a television show but is a menace that citizens must help fight by cooperating with law enforcement officials, he said.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover said in an article in Parade Magazine that the public can cooperate by reporting information on criminal activities and by refusing to deal with criminals, even to the extent of making small, illegal bets.

2 Versions Of Stayman

There are two main versions of Stayman, forcing and non-forcing, respectively. In forcing Stayman the bidding must continue to two no-trump or higher. In non-forcing Stayman it may stop anywhere from two diamonds on up.

Jacoby-Stayman is strictly of the non-forcing variety. The two club response is artificial as in all forms but the opener must respond as follows:

- Two spades with four or more spades.
- Two hearts with four or more hearts and less than four spades.
- Two diamonds with any other holding.

Playing Jacoby-Stayman, North has no problem in responding to his partner's no-trump. He bids two clubs and plans to pass irrespective of his partner's answer.

East and West can make three clubs, but it is rather difficult for either of them to get into the bidding against the opening no-trump.

There is no defense against two spades. In the actual play South ruffed the opening club lead in dummy and led a low diamond to his king. West won with the ace and shifted to a trump. East cashed the ace and led back another trump. South cashed the queen of diamonds and ruffed a diamond.

He hoped to set up two diamond tricks in dummy, but when the suit failed to break South had to content himself by ruffing one more club with dummy's last trump and winding up with exactly eight tricks.
