



UNUSUAL DESSERT — Ruby-hued Flame Tokay grapes are dipped in cheese mixtures to make "Tokay Europa" a dessert with a definite flair. California grapes just coming into the markets are crisp and sweet from sunshine and care.

A European Touch To Dessert

The California vineyards are ready for the harvesting. Thousands of acres of grapes ripen under hot sunshine, and the wineries are waiting. Trucks will soon be piled high with picking boxes loaded with the multi-colored, multi-flavored fruit and part of it will find its way to Klamath Falls markets.

A new idea for the use of fresh grapes came to the food desk this week and it is so simple we pass it on to you.

Fresh fruit eaten out-of-hand for dessert in the Continental tradition is given a new flavor twist in Tokay Europa. Crisp Flame Tokay grapes are dipped in a choice of three different creamy cheese mixtures, accompanied by wedges of Gouda cheese and crackers. It's a dinner finale that can be prepared on the spur of the moment. And luscious Tokays will certainly spur guests on to hearty dipping.

TOKAY EUROPA

1 lb. large Tokay grapes
Cheddar Cheese Dip
Swiss Cheese Dip
Blue Cheese Dip
Small Gouda

Cheddar Cheese Dip
1/4 cup grated cheddar cheese
1/4 cup dairy sour cream

Swiss Cheese Dip
1/2 cup grated Swiss cheese
1/4 cup dairy sour cream

Blue Cheese Dip
1 (3 oz.) package cream cheese
2 tablespoons milk
3 tablespoons crumbled blue cheese

Wash Tokays; snip with scissors into individual-size clusters. Arrange on dessert plates or in large bowl. Pass cheese dips on a large tray for dipping grapes.

Cheddar Cheese dip: Combine ingredients.

Swiss Cheese dip: Combine ingredients.

Blue Cheese dip: Soften cream cheese with milk; blend with blue cheese.

Small Gouda: Cut into wedges or serve whole with cheese knife.

TOKAYS AND CHICKEN

That highly-respected member of the poultry family, chicken, receives a fancy flavor lift from that highly-esteemed product of the vineyard, Flame Tokay grapes, in "Chicken Broadway." The combination makes for mar-quee magic in the kitchen. The crisp Tokays supply delightful texture for an orange-and-curry-flavored sauce that is served over broiled chicken. Garnish the platter with handsome whole Tokays and the result will be a high-style but easy-to-do entree.

CHICKEN BROADWAY

1-3 cup butter or margarine
1/2 teaspoon curry powder
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon paprika
Dash pepper
2 (3 to 3 1/2 lb.) frying chickens, halved
2 cups Tokay grapes
1/2 (6 oz.) can frozen orange juice concentrate
2 tablespoons cornstarch
1 cup water
Melt butter with curry powder, salt, paprika and pepper. Place
