

Fall TV Highlights

NEW YORK (UPI)—Ed Sullivan's Sylvan Productions is busily engaged in creating new television programs. Besides the previously announced "Loveable Louie" comedy series about a chimp, the firm has in work a dramatic sequence called "The Whip," which concerns a state senator, and a situation comedy about a volunteer fire department entitled "The Twentieth Volunteers."

Among the documentary entertainers that NBC refers to as "actualities" being planned for the new season are "The Ganges," a feature on India's famous river; "Orient Express"—A window on Eastern Europe; "American Carnival"; a show on private art collections; and David Brinkley in "Our Man on the Mississippi."

ABC will be back again with its "Challenge Golf" series featuring Arnold Palmer and Gary Player as a team against other top pro golfers. There will be 13 matches, and ABC will televise them in color for the first time.

Last season the Palmer-Player team won nine of the 13 matches. The new series, filmed during the summer, goes on the air Jan. 11.

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Raymond Burr Offers Art Collecting Tips

HOLLYWOOD (UPI)—As an art dealer, I think the question I'm asked most frequently by people wanting to start building an art collection is, "how do you start?"

First let me say that the most important prerequisites for such a move are courage and taste. Wealth is the least of it.

In America, very good collections are owned by people of relatively modest means who had the courage to start collecting and the taste to collect wisely.

Courage to make your first purchase and to continue buying—and courage to admit your mistakes—are the first steps to be mastered. With each step the new collector becomes more assured. Taste is more personal and it depends on the type of individual you are as to what you buy. Frequently a collector starts by concentrating on the paintings of a single artist whose work he admires.

The magnificent collection of Matisse's now in the Baltimore Museum of Art was assembled in this fashion. Two sisters bought one Matisse each year for 19 years, and at the end of this period they had, in addition to the beauty of the works themselves, an illuminating study of this great painter's creative development.

There is a lesson to be learned in the fact that they purchased only one painting a year; it is far better to invest in one good painting than a half dozen of dubious quality. Every collector must learn to discipline his desire for acquisition.

Often a collector who concentrates at the outset on one artist soon extends his view to other painters of the same school or period.

Of course, there are collectors who fear to express their own judgment and seek guidance from a dealer. The great Havemeyer Collection, now in the Metropolitan Museum in New York, was made with the guidance of the dealer Durand-Ruel. The Mellon Collection in the National Gallery of Washington was born of the collaboration of Andrew Mellon, the financier, and the art dealer Lord Dawson.

There are many interesting avenues to travel in collecting art. With the aid of books and some exploratory visits to galleries and museums, the beginning collector may be equipped to chart his own course.

I happen to be a collector who purchases art "by eye." The pictures in my personal collection represent many artists of many periods. I selected each personally because, through my eye, it addressed itself to me.

They have led me to a deeper appreciation of the wonder of line, form and color that, on a bit of canvas, can depict the nobility of man and the beauty of God's world.

Certainly, the benefits derived from building an art collection are not merely the increasing value of your investment, the "social status" which may be attained, nor even in the beauty that surrounds the owner of the pictures. Rather, I think, it exists in the development of eye and self that results from the companionship of paintings.

That is why I say to the young collector: Get started—buy a picture. Have courage—buy one picture, buy two pictures—and move ahead, every man in his own way.

Oberon Returns To Films After 5 Years
