P.S.—You can make pretty note paper by cutting off, with the pinking shears, the letterhead of some outmoded stationery and then pinning the bottom of the sheet to match.

DEAR POLLY—If you put up your paper towel rack in a vertical position and tear the towels down rather than across, they come off neatly.
