High-Level Meet To Test 'Thaw'

NEW YORK (UPI)—The Big Three foreign ministers' meeting here Saturday shapes up as a cautious test of the extent of the cold war "thaw" rather than a negotiating session on specific issues, high American officials said today.

Secretary of State Dean Rusk expects no surprising new proposals to ease East-West tension from Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei Gromyko at this point, his aides said.

He does hope, however, to discover whether Russia's new cordiality toward the West—together with Moscow's almost complete break with Red China—has improved chances for reasonable negotiations on Berlin and other critical issues.

Rusk will be the host at a working lunch for Gromyko and British Foreign Secretary Lord Home, who arrived from London today.

Inclusion of Lord Home in the first top-deck East-West meeting of the current United Nations assembly appeared to rule out discussion of purely bilateral matters such as the Soviet-American commercial aviation agreement.

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UN Force Nearly Out Of Money

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (UPI) — Authorization to maintain a 5,000-man U.N. military force in the Congo until next July faces an uphill fight in the General Assembly, diplomats said today.

A special assembly session last June voted \$33 million to keep the U.N. force in the far-from-settled country until the end of the year. Secretary General Thant has served notice he will be powerless to continue the operation beyond Dec. 31 unless the current assembly session votes a new appropriation next week.

The assembly's 111-nation administrative and budgetary committee, which will carry the brunt of this year's Congo debate, held its first meeting of the year today while the world parliament met concurrently to continue its policy debate with speeches by Chad, Denmark, Romania, Cambodia, Senegal, Panama, Burma and Uganda.

Thant scaled the U.N. Congo force down from a 1961 peak strength of about 20,000 men to 7,795 early this month, and planned to disband it completely by the end of the year.

Congo Prime Minister Cyrille Adoula pleaded for the retention of a 3,000-man force in the country at least until mid-1964 to maintain order and help train Congo forces. The United States and other Western powers backed his request.

Cost Of Living Remained Steady In August

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The cost of living held steady in August and there are no signs of any strong inflationary trend before the end of the year, the Labor Department reported today.

The Bureau of Labor Statistics said lower food prices offset increases in transportation and recreation costs last month. As a result, the department's price index held steady at the July level of 107.1. This was 1.5 per cent higher than a year ago, however.

The food index dropped two tenths of 1 per cent in August as sharp declines in prices of fresh fruits and vegetables more than offset higher prices for meat, fresh milk and eggs.

The drop meant that a housewife could purchase for \$10.60 in August the same market basket of food that cost \$10.62 in July and \$10 in the base period 1957-59.

The department also reported that net spendable earnings of factory production workers dropped between July and August but still their weekly pay check was 39 cents larger than a year ago.

The drop, the second in two months, reflected a 2 cent cut in average hourly earnings, resulting mainly from seasonal declines in employment in high-wage industries.

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The housing index held steady last month at the July level but was 1.1 per cent above a year ago. Transportation costs averaged one half of 1 per cent higher and clothing edged up slightly, largely because of price increases for men's wear.

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There now are nearly 14 million American families in which both the husband and the wife are working, reports the U.S. Department of Labor.

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
