South Saved By Transfer

In ordinary bidding the only way you can stop short of game after your partner opens with two no-trump is to pass. The Jacoby Transfer Bid (JTB) makes it possible for you to get out of two no-trumps into three of a major suit and to let the no-trump hand play the contract.

North doesn't have even a ten spot, and in spite of the fact that he holds a six card spade suit North doesn't want to play game. He doesn't want to play very high contract, but he is sure that three spades will be far better than two no-trump and the JTB makes it possible for the hand to play at three spades.

North bids three hearts and South goes to three spades. Of course, South goes into a mild state of shock when North passes. No one is interested in a part score when he holds 23 points in high cards.

West opens the queen of hearts and South is less perturbed. True, he sees some slight chance to make four spades, but he is happy about the whole thing. He is 90 per cent sure that he will make three spades which is exactly what he makes.

He wins the heart and leads a trump. West takes his ace and leads another heart, whereupon South pulls trumps and starts after the clubs and diamonds. He has to lose two diamonds and a club, but four defensive tricks does not set a contract of three spades.

Bill Assures Better Status

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Congress has been catching a lot of criticism lately, some of it undoubtedly justified.

But I say that any legislative body that passes a bill to prevent Merchant Marine nurses from being classified as "nurses and wipers" can't be all bad.

This bill, which President Kennedy signed on Tuesday, rectifies a situation that developed under a recent job reclassification by the Coast Guard.

It was, moreover, the type of thing that Rep. Jim Wright, D-Tex., apparently had in mind the other day when he undertook to answer charges that Congress had been dilly-dallying, distorting and dawdling this year.

Wright contended that it has taken Congress longer to do less than is normally the case.

"But," he said, "what most of the critics fail to take into account is that the record of Congress simply cannot be judged by the number of laws passed.

"It must be judged instead by the wisdom of the laws enacted. Quality, not quantity, should be the criterion."

Any fair-minded person, I submit, can see the wisdom of giving nurses the embarrassment of carrying being called nurses and wipers, even though that title might accurately describe their duties.

Wright might have added still another point to his defense of Congress. But since he didn't, I will do it for him. I refer to the fact that it oftentimes takes as much or more time for Congress to pass a bill as it does to pass one open for business.

In gauging the pace at which our lawmakers operate, most critics simply do not take into account the hours that they spend just passing legislation.

Some bills, of course, are not so important as others. As introduced, consigned to the near-pigeonhole and forgotten.

But a major piece of legislation that has not passed cannot be so easily passed. It requires lengthy committee hearings and debate on the floor before it can be passed.

And it uses up a lot of wisdom in the process.
