Experts Rate NY Yankees, Defense As Sharply Superior To LA Dodgers

NEW YORK (UPI)—The Yankees' defense is so much better than the Dodgers' that there is really no comparison.

Nothing, but nothing that can possibly be handled ever gets by the Yankee infield. And little ever gets by their outfield, either.

Unfortunately for the Dodgers, the same can't be said for their infield or their outfield.

Yankee manager Ralph Houk, who invariably prefers to soft-peddle his own team's advantages and upgrade the other team's, says the Dodgers may rise to the occasion on defense during the World Series.

"I've seen players, who were supposed to be poor fielders, come up with the big play in the World Series time after time," he claims.

Maybe Houk's eyesight is better than most but the fact remains that no one else can ever remember seeing a so-called "butcher" in the field decide the World Series with his glove.

Two Different Leagues

The simple truth of the matter is that the Yankees are in an entirely different league than the Dodgers when it comes to defense. That goes on paper or on the field.

Figures can be made to prove anything, of course, but there is no way to distort the fact that the Yankees have committed 50 fewer errors than the Dodgers and have executed 35 more double plays.

In composite percentage, the Yankees' fielding mark is approximately eight points higher than the Dodgers and that's nearly worlds apart when you work out defensive averages.

Forget the figures, though, and look at the men they represent.

Let's go to the outfield first. Roger Maris ranks as one of the finest right fielders in the American League while his Dodger counterpart, Frank Howard, still has trouble at the position.

Mantle is tops

Mickey Mantle, even with a gimpy leg, leaves little to be desired in center field and although Willie Davis is faster, he doesn't make the plays Mantle does.

Tom Tresh amazed onlookers with his defensive performance in left field during the 1962 World Series with the Giants. He has

improved since then and his sure-handedness is all the more remarkable considering he came up to the Yankees as a shortstop.

Tommy Davis is a better than average left fielder but there is no guarantee that Dodger manager Walt Alton won't also use him at third base on occasion during the Series.

Alton never really has come up with a set infield. His best defensive unit is comprised of Ron Fairly at first base, Dick Tracewski at second, Maury Wills at shortstop and Jim Gilliam at third. To get more punch in the

lineup, however, he has moved Gilliam to second and played either Tommy Davis or Ken Mullen at third.

Have Solid Infield

No matter how the Dodgers set up their infield however, it never rates on a par with the Yankees. In Joe Pepitone, the Yanks have their finest fielding first baseman since George McQuinn and Pepitone covers a lot more ground than McQuinn ever did.

Bobby Richardson takes a back seat to no one with the possible exception of Pittsburgh's Bill Mazeroski at second base, Tony

Kubek rarely makes a mistake at short and Clete Boyer generally is classed with the best defensive third basemen of the past two decades.

That leaves catching where some may give Johnny Roseboro an edge over Elston Howard but even that would be debatable. Howard doesn't have much trouble with low balls, blocks the plate as well as anyone else around and handles the Yankee pitchers perfectly.

Regardless of what angle you look at both defenses, the Yankees have all the better of it.
