

Center Attempts To Curb Juvenile Delinquency By Aiding Youths Out Of School And Out Of Work

 WASHINGTON (NEA)—In the drive on juvenile delinquency, a Youth Jobs Center in New York's Lower East Side tried to place young men and women in 21 jobs in the regular labor market. It's part of New York's city-backed Mobilization for Youth Project.

The doors are open to dropouts and high school graduates, to youth with clean records and to parolees or probationers, to gang members and "loners." It's one of the new pilot experiments in meeting juvenile delinquency now being tried in more than 40 cities through the U.S. and reported upon in recent Congressional hearings on delinquency.



When mother is the only member of the family to find work, sociologists have found, grave consequences may result for the youth in such a home.

Problem: The Youth Jobs Center has found only 10 per cent of the youth are sufficiently skilled to get jobs in the open market. So the center has worked out a series of solutions for the 19 youths who have taken a "so what" attitude toward life.

Those who cannot qualify for jobs are sent to the Urban Youth Service Corps. There, youths with little work experience go into two weeks of "work exploration," trying out several types of jobs while being paid 75 cents an hour. This gets them started.

Graduates of the work exploration course are then assigned to one of the center's projects where they're sharing the cost. The hope is that at the end of the contract the employer will give the trainee a job.

Many officials reported their first attempts were aimed at getting youngsters off the streets with recreation programs. This helped. But delinquency didn't go away. Most became convinced that jobs were one major answer.

In New Haven, Conn., a delinquent boy put it this way: "You drop out of school and have all this time on your hands and nothing to do, so you get bored. You don't have a job and your parents are on your back, and so you figure you will just go out and do the best you can even if it means breaking and entering."

In Detroit in 1962, there were an estimated 30,000 unemployed youth between the ages of 16 and 21 who had completed school. In recent years more than half the graduates of some high schools in the center of Detroit have been unemployed. Youths between the ages of 17 and 20 accounted for nearly one-third of all major crimes in Detroit in 1961.

In one 12-block section of North Philadelphia, 80 per cent of the youth are out of school and out of work; more than 20 per cent of the births in that section are illegitimate.

Mitchell Sviridoff, executive director of Community Progress, Inc., New Haven, Conn., explains the connection between unemployment and delinquency this way: "The father is usually unskilled and therefore irregularly employed. And in many cases the mother has better chances of finding employment. This serious situation weakens the father's role and gives the mother the dominant place in the family. The effect upon growing boys is undesirable."

Marriage Broker Boasts 35 Years Of Successfully Playing Mating Game

 NEW YORK (UPI)—Boy looks for girl. Boy meets several girls, thanks to Irving Field. And boy usually falls in love with one of the girls and settles into the happy state of matrimony.

"I don't close a case without results," declared Field, who calls himself the dean of New York's marriage brokers. For 35 years Field, a dapper little man with black mustache, has been middle-man in the intricate mating game.

"This is a matrimonial agency," said Field, "not a lonely hearts club. Arranging dates as such is not my job. These people who come here have tried on their own everywhere to meet a marriage prospect without success. They come from all walks of life, all ages. I match up mutual backgrounds. It's got to click."

"Loneliness at some time strikes everybody," said Field in an interview at his 42nd St. office where the decor is living room formal rather than stark office modern. A big sign on one wall proclaims, "Our service is personal and strictly confidential."

Scattered about are wedding photographs of couples he said he'd introduced.

Field estimated he has arranged an average of 100 marriages a year and said that so far as he can determine in a quiet follow-up the couples have been "contented for life. No divorces," he said.

The marriage broker, born in Poland, came to the United States as a child and developed the smoothly operating match-making business he has today by taking over from his father. He said that over 90 per cent of his "customers" are recommended by former clients, their friends and relatives. And many of his young women for whom he's found a mate who was registered by the girl's parents without her knowledge.

Field said he interviews each prospect in depth—with a casual chat at first, because many callers are nervous and often a bit embarrassed at being there. But as they grow more at ease, he begins to take notes on personality, job, salary and other financial assets, age, education, appearance and religion.

He said his clients these days are about evenly split among the Protestant, Catholic and Jewish religions. But he will not make a difference in religion. "I personally don't approve of mixed marriages," he said. "And when there are children, it often comes on their own."

Elimination Not Illegal

SALEM (UPI)—Elimination of the deduction for federal income taxes from the state's tax laws is not illegal, Atty. Gen. Robert Y. Thornton said today.

Thornton received a letter from an Elmira housewife who questioned the legality of the 1963 legislative tax increase measure because it eliminated the federal deduction.

"Thornton did not identify the woman by name, said he replied "because the question is of general public concern."

"When one understands that the income tax is a tax upon income, it becomes apparent that there is no such thing as a 'tax upon a tax' when talking of deductions allowed in determining taxable income," Thornton explained.
