Jury Returns Guilty Verdict

PORTLAND (UPI) — Leo Carl Dean, 36, Portland, was found guilty of second degree murder by a Circuit Court jury of seven women and five men here Tuesday afternoon.

Dean, a television repairman, was charged with fatally beating a 4-year-old boy, Ricky Schmidt. The jury returned its verdict, which was 11 to 1, after deliberating about two hours. The trial ran seven days.

Sentencing was scheduled for next Wednesday.


