Refrigerated storage is no longer a problem for boaters or station wagon motorists with the new portable thermoelectric refrigerators that operate on their own rechargeable power source as well as on AC and DC current. Frozen foods may also be stored in an ice chest for up to 12 hours.

FRANKFURTER BOATS
1 package frozen Welsh Rarebit
1 (1 1/2 oz.) package frozen whipped potatoes (or 1 cup dehydrated potato flakes)
6 frankfurters
Heat frozen Welsh Rarebit as package directs. Add milk to frozen whipped potatoes as package directs. Cook frankfurters in boiling water to cover for 15 minutes, then split in half lengthwise. Spoon whipped potatoes into packet of split frankfurters and top with hot rarebit. Makes 6 servings.

CHILLED POTATO SOUP WITH BASIL

Using a can of frozen condensed cream of potato soup, make vegetable soup according to directions on can. Add 1/2 teaspoon basil and keep chilled in thermos jug, refrigerator or ice chest until ready to serve. Makes three servings.

Barbecue Beef Toasties

Surprise the children with Barbecue Beef Toasties when they come home from school for lunch. Toast slices of bread under broiler. Slice chilled corned beef and place on toast slices. Spread bottled barbecue sauce over corned beef. Top each with a slice of cheese. Put under broiler until cheese is melted and bubbly.

THREE-BEAN SALAD
1 (10 oz.) package frozen blackeye peas
1 (10 oz.) package frozen lima beans
1 (10 oz.) package frozen wax beans
1 medium onion, thinly sliced
1/4 cup bottled Italian salad dressing
1 tomato, sliced
Cook frozen blackeye peas in 1 1/2 cups of boiling salted water.
