

Extra Water Left In NW Reservoirs

BOISE (UPI)—Many Reclamation Bureau reservoirs in the Pacific Northwest will end the 1963 irrigation season with a substantial amount of water left in the reservoirs.

Nelson said reports covering 44 reclamation reservoirs in the Northwest indicated a total usable storage content of more than 12,400,000 acre feet on Oct. 1. Last year at that time the usable storage content was 12,215,000 acre feet.

"The storage holdover on a number of projects assures normal water deliveries on these projects next year even though streamflow may be less than normal," Nelson said.

Normal irrigation water supplies were available on all areas served by the reservoirs except for the Wapinitia project and for parts of the Umatilla project, both in north-central Oregon.

Storage content of six reservoirs — Jackson Lake, Island Park, Grassy Lake, Palisades, American Falls and Lake Walcott on the upper Snake river in Idaho and Wyoming — was 1,789,000 acre feet Oct. 1. That's the same as last year for this time.

For Anderson ranch, Arrowrock, Lucky Peak and Lake Lowell on the Boise River system in southwestern Idaho the usable storage content was 574,000 acre feet — 64,000 more than last year.

In the Owyhee Reservoir of eastern Oregon the usable storage was up at 242,000 acre feet from 173,000 last year. Usable storage in Agency Valley and Warm Springs reservoirs of eastern Oregon was 52,000 acre-feet compared with only 2,000 a year ago. Bully Creek reservoir, completed only last summer, contained 4,000 acre feet of storage water Oct. 1.

Reservoir storage carry-over on the Crooked River project in central Oregon is high, Nelson said. On Oct. 1 Ochoco Reservoir contained 20,000 acre-feet and Prineville reservoir 102,000.

Usable storage in Howard Prairie, Emigrant and Hyatt Prairie reservoirs in the Talent division of the Rogue River Basin project of southwestern Oregon was 76,000 acre-feet Oct. 1. Nelson said this assures adequate irrigation water for the project next year even if streamflow is far below normal.

Americans Having Trouble Celebrating Tax Forms' Birthday

WASHINGTON (UPI) — I hadn't realized until just this week that 1963 is the 50th anniversary of the 1040 federal income tax form.

The anniversary was called to my attention by Mortimer M. Caplin, our friendly revenue commissioner, at a press conference where he unveiled the latest edition of form 1040 — the one that will be used to collect this year's taxes.

As usual, Caplin is relentlessly cheerful. If he were a dentist, he undoubtedly would hang out a sign reading "painless extractions."

But on this occasion he also seemed a bit wistful, and it occurred to me that perhaps his feelings were hurt because nobody has been celebrating the anniversary.

No Offense Intended
If so, I would like to assure him that no offense was intended. The trouble is that we Americans have not had any experience celebrating golden anniversaries of tax forms. We don't know how to go about it.

trying to think of some appropriate commemoration but nothing comes to mind.

Possibly one of us should compose a little tribute to form 1040, calling it "fifty years of the income tax" or "where did all the flowers go?"

As for the new 1040, there is nothing much to report other than to observe that it has once again been "simplified."

Simplified Form
The first 1040, printed in 1913, covered four pages, including instructions. Since then it has been simplified to the point where it now comes in a package running to about 40 pages.

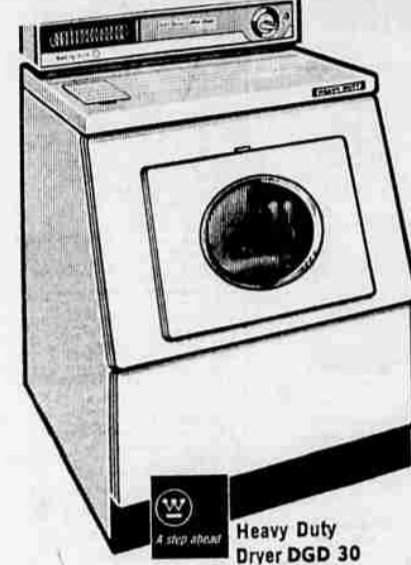
There has been one major innovation this year. The new 1040 package has a window. But don't get your hopes up. It isn't big enough to jump out of.

The window was cut in the front page so that the taxpayer's name and address on the second page would be visible.

In the course of introducing the new 1040, Caplin presented some statistics on tax collecting which I found rather encouraging. For example, his men caught 225 million mathematical errors in 75 million cases would have benefited the taxpayer. Had they benefited the government and in those are better odds than you they gone undetected, the errors 150 million cases would have can get at Las Vegas.

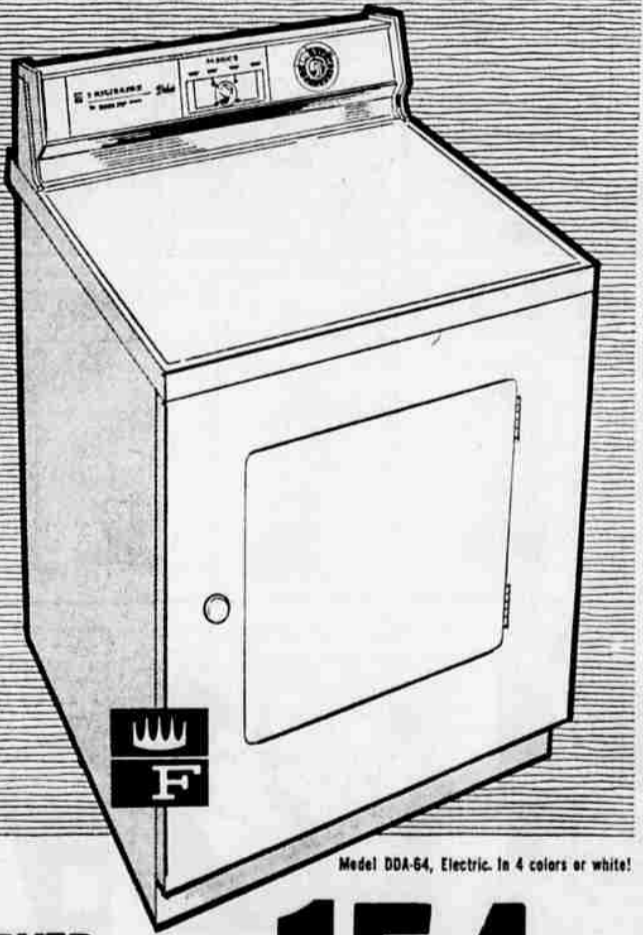
