

British Policewomen Dodge 'Christine Questions' During U.S. Tour

Eleven private Oregon colleges were represented during a college visitation to KUIS on Wednesday, Oct. 9. "Their trip was crowded with visits with law enforcement officials—the whole idea was one of furthering the good will between the law enforcement agencies of the United States, Canada and England. When he is playing the part of Joey Bishop's son he is actually acting. But when he is playing the part of a baby he is not acting. This is because the part of Joey Bishop's wife is played by Abby Dalton, who is the baby's real mother. Miss Dalton, or Mrs. Smith, was here on a promotion tour this week and I asked her if using her own baby on the show came under the heading of "type casting."
