A Halloween potluck dinner and costume party is slated Friday night, Oct. 25.

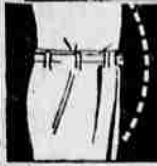
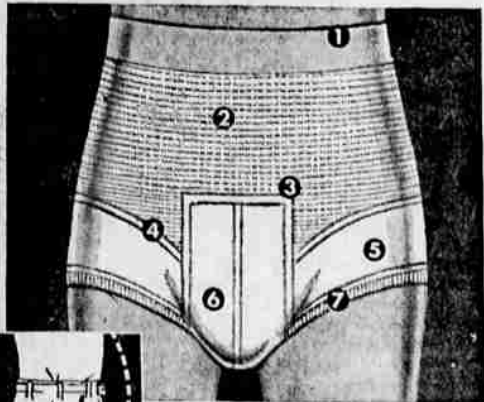

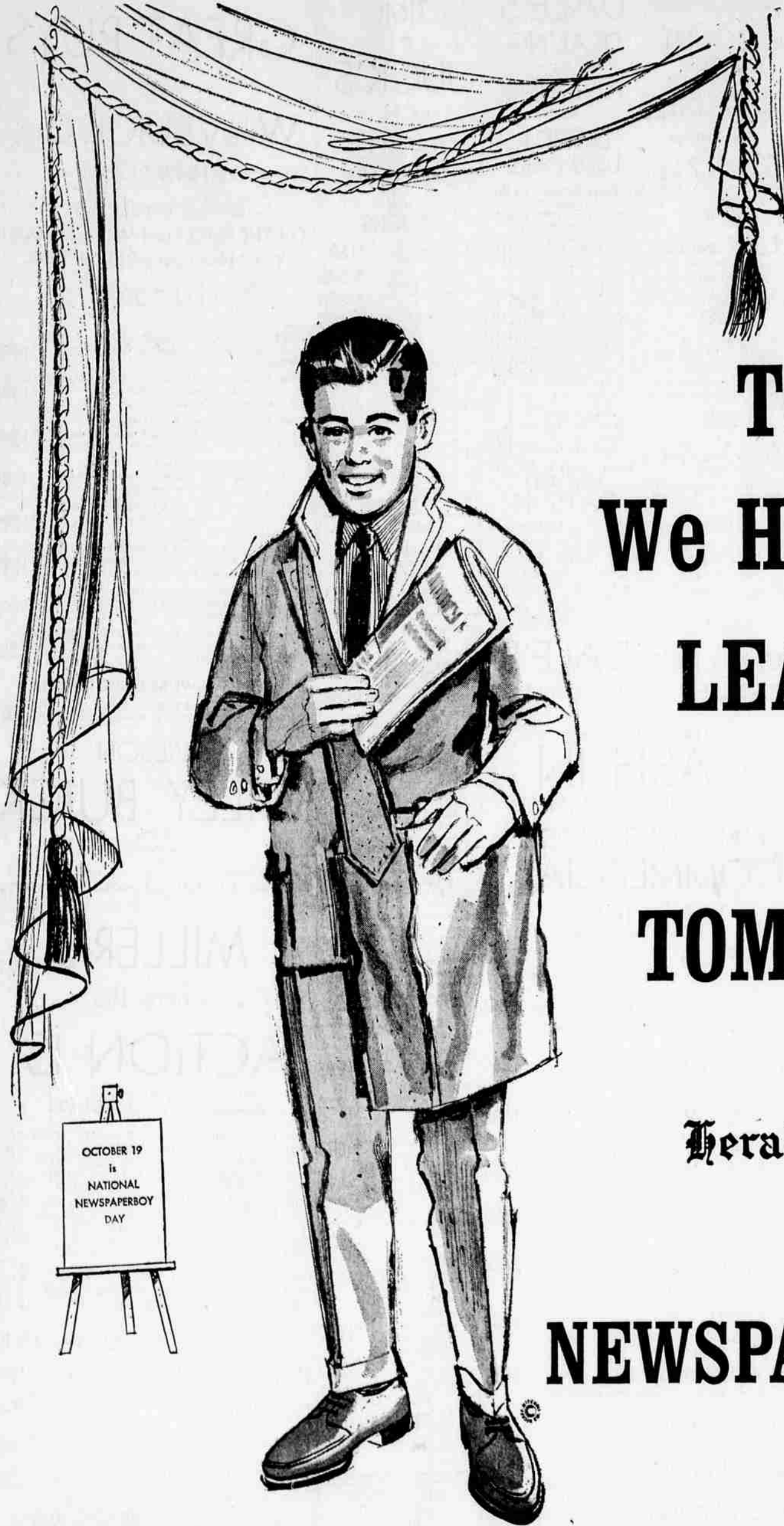
