Nicklaus Battles Many Hazards In Taking Win

PARIS (UPI)—Jack Nicklaus not only proved himself the greatest golfer in the world today but he also could give the U.S. mail a lesson.
The Post Office brag about going through sleet, snow and dark of night, but the big kid from Ohio went through icy breezes, soggy mud and pea soup fog to beat the best from 33 nations, win the individual International Trophy and sweep Uncle Sam to its fourth straight Canada Cup team victory.
It was Nicklaus' first appearance in this international tournament and Arnold Palmer gave his Yankee teammate all the credit.
"Jack did it, no question about it," said Palmer.
Where he did it, and Palmer put the icing on the cake, was on the sixth hole on the St. Nom la Breche course which was so shrouded in fog that the final round had to be cut to nine holes, making it a 63-hole tournament instead of the scheduled 72.
The U.S. had started out the day tied with Spain for the team lead and the Spaniards, playing ahead of the Americans were three shots back after five holes. It looked like it was going to be a real race when both Nicklaus and Palmer trapped their approaches. But Nicklaus, who had four birdies in the first five holes, made it five birdies in six holes when he blasted out of the trap into the cup—73 yards away. Palmer came out on the green and sank his putt for a par and the U.S. was in.
The 23-year-old Nicklaus also won the individual championship. He had started out the day tied with Gary Player of South Africa and Jack knew he had his work cut out for him when Player eagled the very first hole.
Starts Birdie Barrage
Jack birdied it and then got going on that birdie barrage. It enabled Jack to finish with a four under par 32 for a total of 237 — five shots ahead of Player and Sebastian Miguel of Spain who tied for the runner-up spot with totals of 242.
Palmer with a two under par had an aggregate of 245—lying him for fifth place with Al Balding of Canada and Bruce Crampton of Australia. Ramon Sota of Spain was third with 243.
In the team race, the U.S., winning its fourth team championship in a row and its sixth in the 11 international tournaments held by the International Golf Association, beat out Spain by three strokes with 482 to 485. South Africa finished third with 492 followed by Canada with 495 and Australia with 497.

Swap Takes McGill To NY Knicks

NEW YORK (UPI)—The New York Knickerbockers of the National Basketball Association today acquired Billy (The Hill) McGill, the nation's leading college scorer in 1961-62, from the Baltimore Bullets in exchange for Paul Hogue and Gene Shue.
The Knickerbockers also announced that they are activating Tom Hoover and will cut another player from their roster before tonight's game with the St. Louis Hawks.
The trade is designed to give the Knicks a high-scoring "big man" they have long needed to make them an Eastern Division title threat. McGill has averaged only 3.2 points a game for Utah in the 1961-62 season and is regarded as potentially a high-scoring pro. He stands 6 feet, 9 inches and weighs about 230 pounds.
Hoover, who also is 6-foot-9, was obtained from Philadelphia on Oct. 19.
Hogue, 6-foot-9, and 240 pounds, was the Knicks' No. 1 draft choice in 1962 after starting at center for two consecutive University of Cincinnati NCAA championship teams. He averaged seven points a game in 50 games last season when he was sidelined for a time with appendicitis.
He is a veteran of nine years in the NBA, five of them with Detroit.

Key Men Called In Probe

BALTIMORE (UPI)—One of Maryland's most controversial politicians, a dead boxer's last opponent and the opponent's manager are due here today before a grand jury probing the death of Baltimore heavyweight Ernie Knox.
The jury has summoned James H. (Jack) Pollack, head of a center of state and city political battles, a Baltimore fight game figure and former member of the Maryland State Athletic Commission; New York heavyweight Wayne Bethea who knocked Knox out in the ninth round at the Coliseum here on Oct. 14 and Bethea's manager, Bobby Gleason.
Pollack, according to state attorney William J. O'Donnell, asked to testify in the case. A probe was launched by the grand jury after an autopsy showed Knox weighed only 153 pounds two days after the fatal fight in which he was officially listed as weighing 178 pounds. Bethea was carded at 205 pounds.
Knox lapsed into a coma several hours after his defeat and died after a 31-hour coma.

Oakland Player Leading

NEW YORK (UPI)—Clem Daniels of the Oakland Raiders matched the San Diego Chargers' two speedboys, Paul Lowe and Keith Lincoln, stride for stride Sunday and beat them out for the American Football League's rushing leadership.
Daniels, quarterback Jack Kemp of the Buffalo Bills and Frank Jackson of the Kansas City Chiefs were this week's three new individual leaders in the league statistics released today. Kemp took over first place in passing and Jackson in punt returns.
Daniels gained 125 yards in 19 carries against San Diego last Sunday to replace Lowe as the AFL rushing leader. Although the 220-pound Oakland halfback missed or was used only sparingly in four games because of a leg injury, he now has gained 322 rushing yards for a 5.6 average.
Lowe gained 82 yards in 12 carries against the Raiders to boost his season total to 502 and a league-leading average of 6.6. Lincoln had the best day of the three, however, amassing 130 yards in 15 tries to move from sixth place to third with a 4.9-yard total and a 6.4 average.
Kemp replaced Tobin Rote of San Diego as passing leader following a big game against the Boston Patriots Saturday night. Kemp has completed 120 of 246 passes for 1,913 yards and nine touchdowns. Len Dawson of Kansas City moved up to second place and Rote dropped back to a third-place tie with George Blanda of the Houston Oilers.
Jackson took over the punt return leadership from Lincoln. Jackson has run back four kicks for an average of 17.7 yards.
