

Medford Man Makes Hobby Of Giving Away Trees To Children

MEDFORD (UPI) — "If I ever get arrested, the children will be on my side."

Speaking was C.C. Hoover, 73, Medford, who during the past five years has given away more than 500,000 trees to school children in six states.

Hoover will add between 20,000 and 30,000 to this total Monday when he gives away trees in Salem. The total is expected to reach a half-million by next June first.

Mr. and Mrs. Hoover started

their tree project under the sponsorship of the Eagle Point Grange, but have continued it as a private public service to beauty communities.

Hoover, who has experimented in agriculture and allied fields throughout his life is continually working to improve his distribution program. Monday in Salem for the first time he will set up an "assembly line" and through the help of local Boy Scouts will sort and pot the trees in preparation to giving

them away.

In the past, the trees were processed at the Hoover farm northeast of Medford.

The trees will include 10 to 15 varieties. The majority will be Norway Spruce, white weeping and other types of birch, and a new white-blue spruce.

The Southern Oregon semi-retired farmer frankly admits that he started out to "landscape Southern Oregon." Now his trees have been planted in California, Washington, Kansas,

New Jersey and New Mexico.

His newest experiment is using Klamath County potatoes as a moisture and nutrient supply for the roots of the seedlings. Many of his birch trees come from Michigan by air, packed with raw chipped potatoes shipped east by Hoover.

Hoover says the children get more enthusiastic every year. To date he has received more than 50,000 letters from "my children."

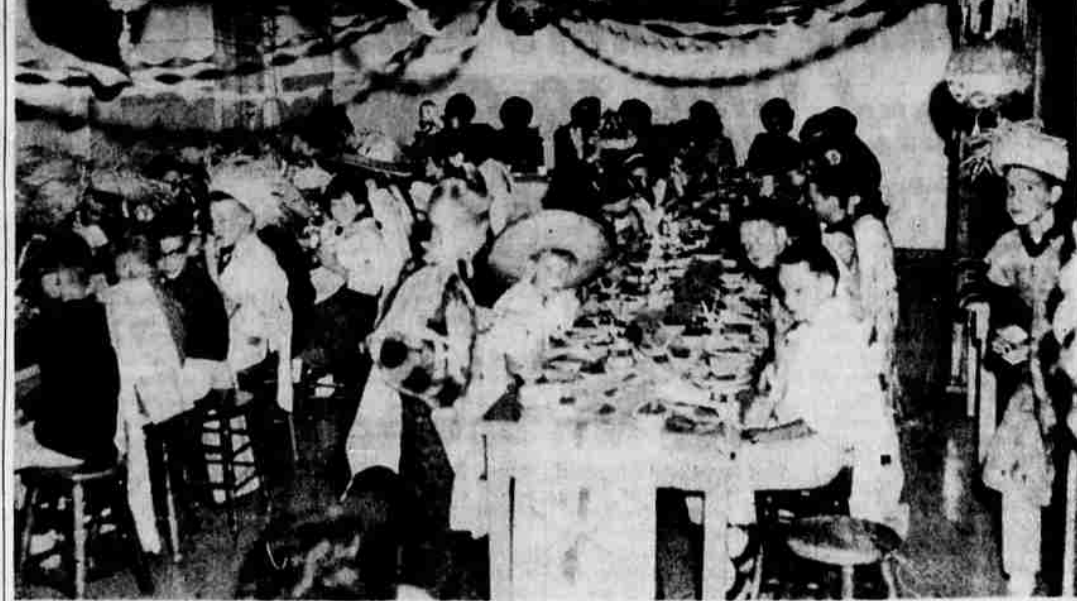
Mr. and Mrs. Hoover were

married in Jacksonville, Ore., in 1913. She has worked with the Oregon State home extension units and the Eagle Point Garden Club. Both are active in the Grange and the Southern Oregon Historical Society. He is a member of the Farm Bureau and several fraternal and civic groups. His grandfather, Dr. George Hoover, was an early-day physician in Roseburg.

For many years Hoover was interested in seed crops and, working with Oregon State University and other scientists, helped to bring about the use of native Jackson County grasses for use in pastures. He is credited with having been the first to sow seed from an airplane, done to publicize the area as a seed-growing center. The effort received nationwide recognition.

In recent years Hoover and his sons have been engaged in buying and selling land in the White City area, the site of Camp White during World War II.

In the tree planting project, 42 varieties have been used, coming from all over the United States.
