Bid Solves Situation

Bill Greive of San Antonio was a member of my team which represented the United States in Italy in 1960. Since that time, his duties with IBM have kept him from playing much bridge, but I did get to play with him for the first time in several years at the recent San Antonio Regionals.

I am glad for his sake that he doesn't have much time for bridge, for my own sake I wish that he had more, as he certainly plays just as well if not better than before.

Bill sat North and passed after West's spade opening. Since we are discussing North-South bidding I won't comment on either that spade opening or East's raise to two spades.

South was not shut out. He bid three diamonds and after West passed it was up to Bill to do something. His first thought was to raise his partner to four, but Bill decided that four would be an underbid and five a distinct overbid. How could he bid four and a half?

Bill figured out how. He cue bid three spades!

South went to three no-trump. He did not know if Bill were showing the ace of spades or just asking South to bid three no-trump with a spade stopper.

Bill knew! He had a singleton heart and was not going to pass three no-trump. He bid four diamonds and had managed to convey the message that he had a hand that called for something between four and five diamonds.

South went on to game and made it easily. In fact, had the club finesse worked, South would have made a slam.

Female Role Draws Fire

ORONO, Main (UPI) — Sen. Margaret Chase Smith, R-Maine recently considered a possible candidate for the Republican presidential nomination, has taken issue with the saying that a woman's place is in the home.

Sen. Smith, a widow, told a University of Maine audience Sunday that women were first of all wives and mothers. But she would dispute those who contend a woman must play no other role.

In a keynote address opening "Women's Week" at the university, Sen. Smith said, "I view the role of wife and mother as the foundation, the keystone and the basis for women to expand their activities and to take on supplementary roles."

"But in acknowledging the home to be the foremost place for women, I want to say very emphatically that their role should not be restricted and limited solely to the home as some backward-looking contend," she said.

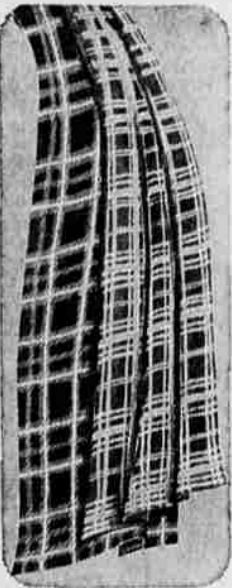

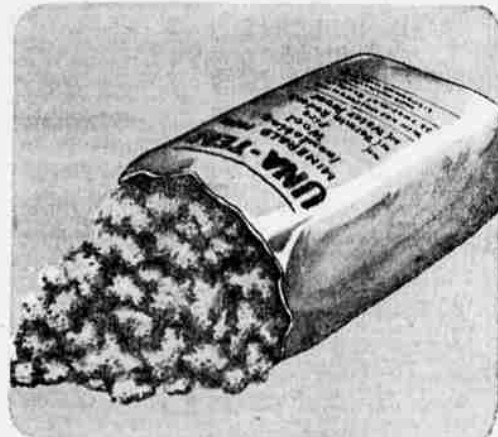
