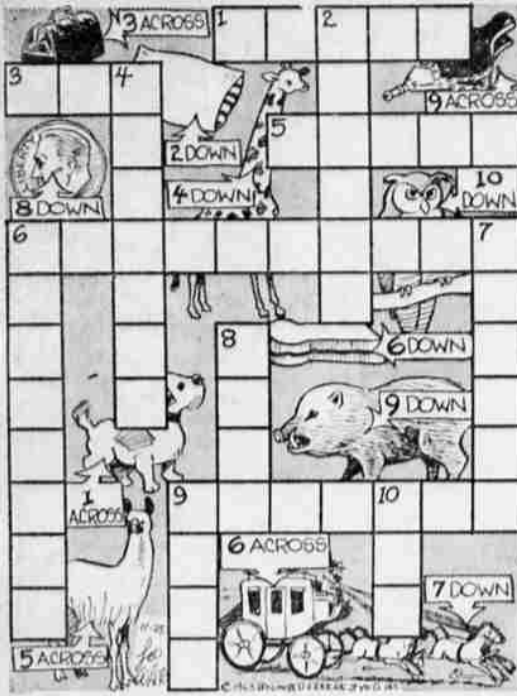


LITTLE PEOPLE'S PUZZLE
