Actually, Mr. Carter, it doesn't seem much different than when he's not home from college.

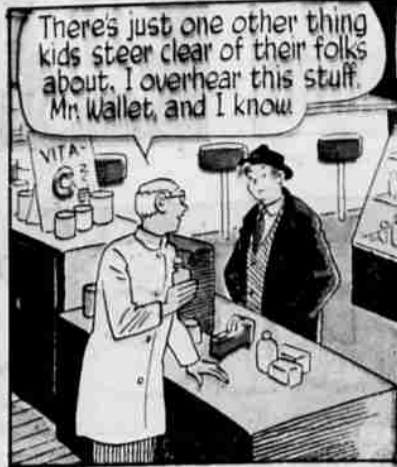


If he doesn't have a date with one of those girls, he's out with his gang. It's almost as if he were dodging us.

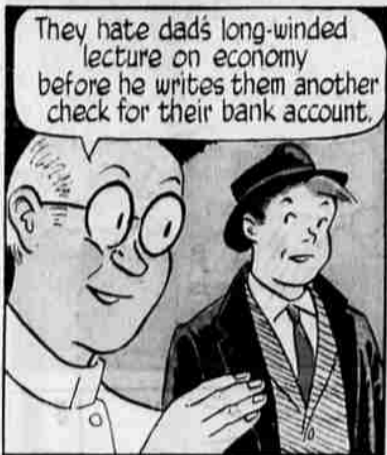


Chipper isn't having trouble with his studies, is he?

No, he's getting As and Bs.



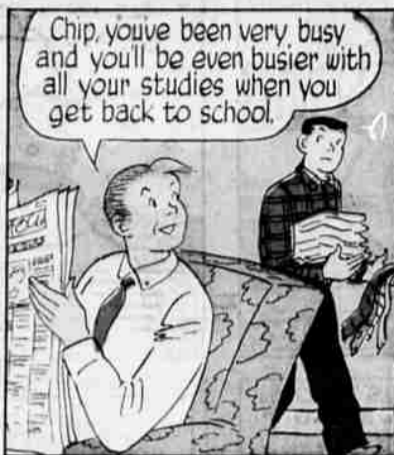
There's just one other thing kids steer clear of their folks about. I overhear this stuff, Mr. Wallet, and I know.

So! They put off till the last minute the painful subject of the bank balance! That's natural!

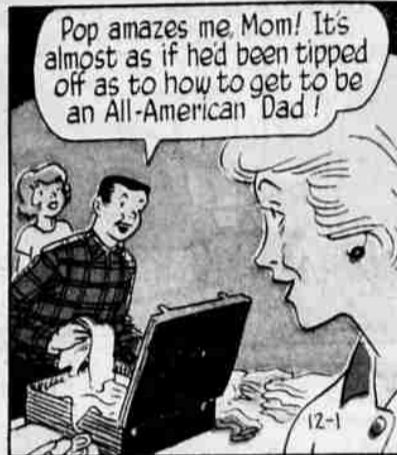


Chip, you've been very busy and you'll be even busier with all your studies when you get back to school.



So I wrote a check for your account and mailed it direct to your bank. Okay?

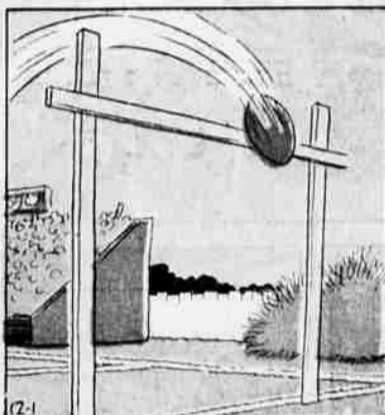
Hm?! Golly, Pop, that's great!
