

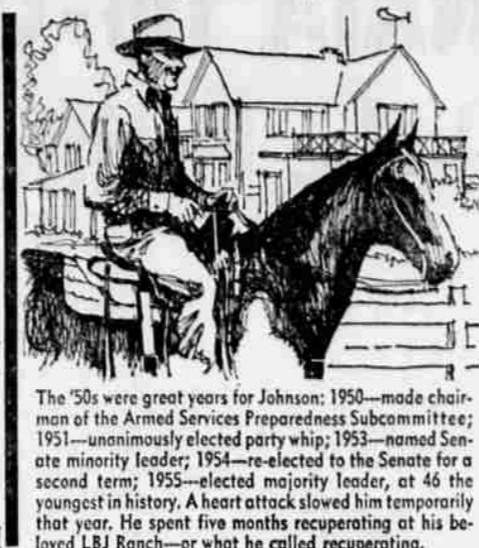
TEXAN IN THE WHITE HOUSE (4)

On Dec. 8, 1941, Rep. Lyndon B. Johnson voted in Congress to declare war on Japan and Germany. The next day, he volunteered for active duty in the Navy and became the first congressman to put on uniform. He received the Silver Star for gallantry in action in the South Pacific.

In 1942, President Roosevelt ordered all members of Congress in the services back to their Washington desks. Johnson's desk was still in the House of Representatives, until 1948, when he made his second bid for the Senate. By the fantastically thin margin of 87 votes out of one million cast, he defeated Gov. Coke Stevenson in a typically uninhibited Texas campaign. Johnson hired a helicopter and literally campaigned by air.



The '50s were great years for Johnson: 1950—made chairman of the Armed Services Preparedness Subcommittee; 1951—unanimously elected party whip; 1953—named Senate minority leader; 1954—re-elected to the Senate for a second term; 1955—elected majority leader, at 46 the youngest in history. A heart attack slowed him temporarily that year. He spent five months recuperating at his beloved LBJ Ranch—or what he called recuperating.

UNVEIL AIRPORT PLANS
FRANKFURT, Germany (UPI)—Plans for a \$86 million terminal building for the Rhein-Main Airport were unveiled today. Officials said the building would include docking space for 70 jetliners and a moving sidewalk for passengers. The Y-shaped building will have a multi-storied garage for cars.

'Bloodhounds' Slate Monday Night Meet

The Klamath Basin Chapter of the American Red Cross announces there will be a meeting of the "Bloodhounds" Monday, Dec. 8, at 8 p.m. in the Lecture Room of the Klamath County Library.

In an effort to provide the blood needed for the sick and injured in this community and to aid our country in the event

of war or disaster, your local Red Cross chapter is asking your help in recruitment of blood donors. With the advent of open-heart surgery, artificial kidneys and other medical advances, the need for blood constantly expands. It is anticipated that the opening of new hospital facilities in Klamath Falls will increase surgery done

locally, again increasing blood usage. At present Klamath County residents use over 100 pints a month supplied by volunteer donors to the Red Cross.

The schedule for all blood drawings in 1964 and information concerning the goal for each employ group will be distributed at the meeting.

A special guest will be Mrs. Bertha Morton, administrator of the Regional Blood Center in Portland, who will discuss the cost and financing of the blood program.

All firms and local organizations are invited to send their representatives to this meeting.

Dissatisfied Buyers Testify In Mail Fraud Case

PENDLETON (UPI)—A number of reply coupons from prospective buyers of land in arid Harney County were admitted as evidence today over defense objections at the mail fraud trial of seven men.

Notations on the coupons indicated many persons who responded to advertising thought lakes and trees were on or near the tract, government attorneys claimed.

The trial was in its third day. More than 15 government witnesses testified Tuesday of their dissatisfaction with land in the area.

The defendants, all from the Los Angeles and Chicago areas, are officials of Harney County Land Development Corp., which sold lots in arid Lake Valley, 22 miles south of Burns.

The first witness, Howard E. Cornett, a Newberg pulp mill employee, testified he had been led to believe the land was surrounded by mountains, lakes and trees.

"I found a lot of sand and jackrabbit bush and that's all," Cornett said. He got his money back, he testified.

Eino Berg, a Seattle carpenter, said he "knew he couldn't make a go of it" after he paid his first visit to the land.

Acting U.S. Attorney Sidney I. Lezak, in his opening statement,

said the land was classified as class 7 grazing land, which is the next class above "cliffs and complete wasteland."

The tracts were purchased for \$24 an acre and were being resold at \$300 an acre with \$5 down and \$5 a month payment, according to testimony.

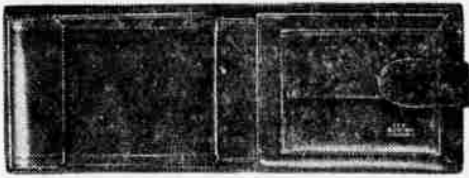
