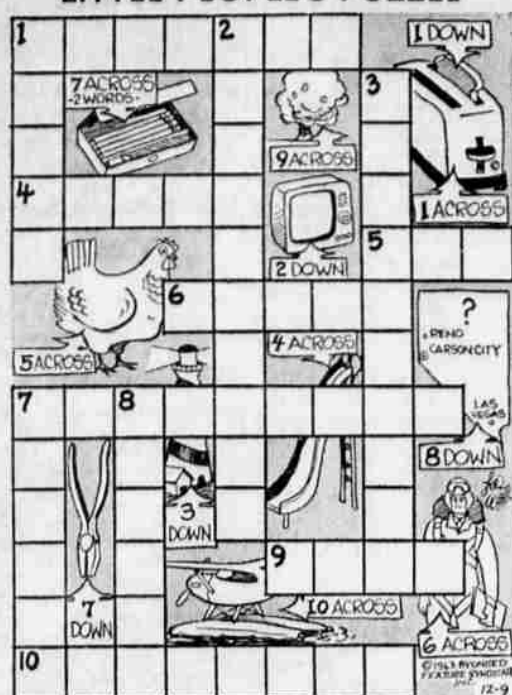


LITTLE PEOPLE'S PUZZLE

McCormack Favors Present Succession Law

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Speaker John W. McCormack Saturday declared himself in favor of the recently-criticized presidential succession law which on the death of John F. Kennedy made him second in line for the White House.

McCormack emphasized that he was speaking as a legislator and not as the man personally involved in the succession problem.

At a news conference, the 71-year-old House leader recalled that he supported the law when it was enacted in 1947 by a Republican Congress on the recommendation of Democratic President Harry S. Truman. He said he still favors it, "not because I'm in it, but because I feel it's the best way of solving the problem."

The law specifies a line of presidential succession which starts with the vice president, followed by the speaker, the Senate president pro tempore, then the secretary of state and the other members of the cabinet.

The present Senate president pro tempore is 62-year-old Sen. Carl Hayden, D-Ariz.

McCormack told newsmen that a review of the succession law is a matter for Congress to

explore if it wishes. But he firmly refused to be drawn into any discussion of recent criticism of the system based partially on the fact that he might succeed to the White House should President Johnson die.

"I don't want to pursue the matter further because it concerns a thought that I don't even want to entertain," he asserted in cutting off questions on the topic.

Several newspapers in McCormack's home state of Massachusetts recently suggested that the speaker should step down from his House leadership post so that a younger man might be named in his stead.

McCormack also refused comment on a statement by former President Dwight D. Eisenhower that the succession law was illogical.

Gen. Eisenhower suggested that the system revert to its previous operation when the cabinet members, led by the secretary of state, were next in line after the vice president.

He said this would insure that no matter what happened to a president or vice president, the

administration would be "headed" in the same political direction.

The main argument on behalf of the present succession law

was that in elevating the speaker and Senate president pro tempore, the president, except in extraordinary situations would be an elected official.

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Joint Operation Initiated

A milestone in military and civil air traffic control was noted Wednesday when the Air Force's Air Defense Command and the Federal Aviation Agency began combined operations in the Great Falls, Mont., SAGE direction center. The center is much like the military installation at Corvallis, Ore., which Kingsley Field uses constantly. News of the consolidation was reported by the Information Office of Kingsley Field.

The FAA's new Great Falls air route traffic control center will make joint use of ADC's operational facilities, computers, long-range radars, and related equipment to provide air traffic control services to civil and military airplanes operating in approximately 135,000 square miles of air space over Montana and the western part of North Dakota.

The integrated air defense-air traffic control facility is part of a program designated Northern Tier Integration Program (NOTIP).

SAGE is the lightning-fast command control system which fills a key role in the network of aerospace defense forces commanded by the Air Defense Command.

The pepperidge tree also is known as sour gum, tupelo and black gum.

The operational commissioning marks the end of FAA's old center and gives the new facility an enlarged control area. The area east of the new center has been extended about 100 miles to include parts of North Dakota which previously lacked FAA radar coverage for civilian planes.
