New Gift Ideas Suggested For The Farmer Who Has Everything

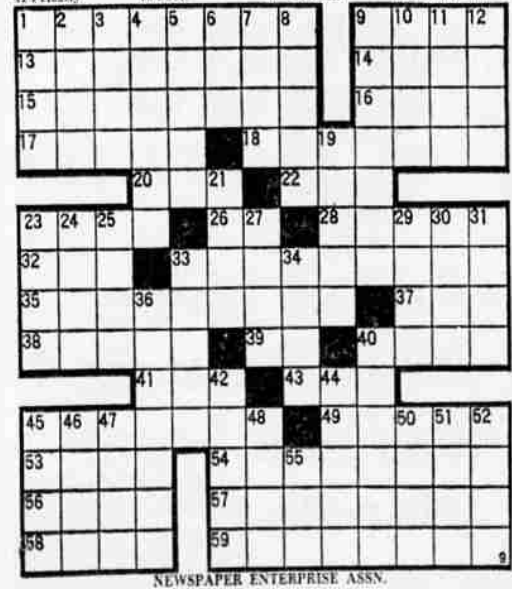

The Agriculture Department's research service has just come up with an item that should make an ideal gift for the hard-to-buy-for granger or husbandman.
It's a fallout shelter for cows. Talk about agrarian status symbols! I would rather have a bovine fallout shelter than an atomic-powered church.
According to the department, this type of shelter has a dual function. It will provide fallout shelter for 30 cows. And in between nuclear attacks, it can serve as a dairy barn.

The shelter also has space for six people. This will, the department notes, "permit the dairyman to care for his livestock during a fallout emergency without leaving the barn."
