Czech Teacher Writes Kennedy Condolences

An expression of sympathy following the death of President John F. Kennedy, has been received from a resident of a Russian satellite country, Czechoslovakia, by Mr. and Mrs. Frank Payr Jr. of Malin. The writer was a teacher, Helen Lindhartova, who has corresponded with Mrs. Payr since the Malin couple was in Europe in 1948. She was on their plane to London where she was going to attend a summer session to study English, to permit her to teach the language in her own country. Mrs. Payr is home economics teacher in the Malin High School. Her husband ranches near Malin. The expression of her sorrow in America's tragedy follows: "I can't find words for expressing my deep sympathy with all the American people. Allow me to express my sympathy at least to you. We all here feel the President's tragic death as a great loss not

only for Americans but for the whole progressive world. "We had a high esteem and respect for your President and his policy. Our newspapers have brought his last photograph with his wife and the governor of Texas—he is laughing there. He was too young! We compare him with A. Lincoln. But as for J. F. Kennedy, he was so young and so wise. He knew that mankind wants peace. "We especially appreciate his policy of supporting the ratification of the treaty in Moscow forbidding atomic tests. "I could not postpone writing you now that your country is having so much grief. I wanted to say, I am with you, I am feeling with you." Frank Payr Jr. is the son of Malin pioneers who helped settle the Malin community in 1909. Holy trees that bear no fruit have only male flowers, incapable of producing seeds.

Boardman Documents Are Signed

SALEM (UPI) — Documents transferring the proposed Boardman Space Age Industrial Park to the State Veterans Agency, and ratifying every phase of the project's development were signed at a seven-minute special meeting of the State Land Board Wednesday. Gov. Mark Hatfield and Treasurer Howard Belton signed the special resolution "ratifying and confirming a recapitulation of the particular negotiations, purchases, sales, transfers and exchanges of land and property which were made in the course of acquiring and creating" the 100,000-acre project in northeastern Oregon. Secretary of State Howell Appling Jr., who was not at the meeting because he attended funeral, submitted a letter indicating he approved the ratification agreement, and would sign it later.

Today's action by the Land Board apparently duplicates legislative action which ratified transactions made to create the park which has been leased to Boeing Co. of Seattle. It was announced transfer of title of 40,000 acres of Navy bombing range property—the final block of property involved in creating the park—is expected to take place later this week. H. C. Saalfeld, director of the State Veterans Affairs Department, said he received a copy of the deed from the Navy Tuesday.

Saalfeld is holding a \$322,000 check for purchase of the land until Navy officials formally sign the deed. He said "I hope we can get it signed this week. I've looked the deed over, and it seems all right." Ownership of the proposed 100,000-acre industrial site was transferred to the Veterans Affairs Department by the special session of the legislature. Attorneys for Boeing Co., which has signed a \$4.6 million, 77-year lease for the property—but which has not yet activated its lease—have asked for details of every transaction involved in the state's purchase and exchange of lands for the project.
