## Sen. Neuberger Praises Brown Move

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Sen. Maurice B. Neuberger, D-Ore., Saturday praised Gov. Edmund G. Brown of California for taking a "giant step" in ordering a state study of the effects of smoking on health.

"The governor has once again placed California in the van-

guard of public health responsibility," Mrs. Neuberger said. Brown this week directed a state advisory committee to develop an education program to protect the health of Californians against cigarette smoking.

Mrs. Neuberger, who has carried on a campaign to point up what she contends are the proven hazards of smoking, said she believed Brown was the first governor to take such a step.

"It is a giant step," she said.

## High Officials In Vatican Worried About Pope's Security During Trip

VATICAN CITY (UPI)—High Vatican officials said Saturday they are worried about the security involved in Pope Paul VI's pilgrimage to the Holy Land.

The trip, from Jan. 4-6, presents the Vatican with a number of new problems—including that of protecting the Pope. Since President John F. Kennedy's assassination, there have been tightened restrictions and a closer guard on the pontiff.

Normally, the job of protecting a Pope falls to the colorful

Swiss Guards. But it is a ceremonial protection since all they carry are ancient halberds and shiny steel breastplates and helmets.

Although they are all ex-military men and train regularly in the use of arms, they do not carry guns on duty. Since Pope Paul's trip is a pilgrimage, they will not be going along. Charged with his protection will be a handful of Vatican gendarmes, the policemen of the Holy See.

About 10 of them will accompany him on the trip, dressed in plain clothes and carrying guns. But the brunt of the chore will fall on the Jordanian and Israeli police.

Vatican police sources said both nations have promised all possible cooperation.

There already has been one public suggestion that there might be trouble.

In Cairo, the newspaper Akhbar Elyom suggested that "Zionists might kill the Pope

during his forthcoming visit to the holy places and accuse the Arabs of doing it."

Another big problem, at least so far as certain officials are concerned, is that of protocol. Pope Paul has emphasized that he is going as a pilgrim, but that does not mean that much of the pomp and ceremony surrounding the pontiff does not remain.

Since this is the first time a pontiff has visited the Holy Land—and the first time since 1812 a Pope has left the confines of modern Italy—he has no precedents.
