(Continued from Page 1) to property is incalculable but he estimated that the loss in personal income may exceed \$2 million. More far-reaching is his appraisal that the bottom land has been so critically damaged that its resource may be forever lost to the economy of the basin.

## Fight Ties

Anderson's problems are no less than those of his neighbors. Portions of his land produce hay and alfalfa but there is doubt that the land will be in condition to raise a crop this year. "If I can't raise any hay this summer I'll just have to sell all my cattle. There's nothing else I can do," he reflected. He then commented generally on the flooding of the Klamath River.

## Loans Available

He noted that three per cent loans are available to ranchers struck by the aftermath of the flood. "But what's the point of pouring \$50,000 into this business when there's so little return on your investment," he added.

## House Passes Poverty Bill

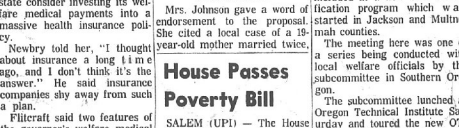
