

Negroes Plan Strategy In Registration Drive

 Martin Luther King Jr. was scheduled to hold a strategy meeting with Negro leaders in Selma, Ala., today regarding a voter registration drive. King flew to Washington and met with President Johnson Tuesday night. He said Johnson reiterated his "belief in achieving the objective" of the right of American citizens to vote and that the administration would support the "broadest possible registration of voters throughout the country."

One of King's top aides, the Rev. Fred L. Shuttlesworth, told a rally of 400 Negroes on Tuesday night at Selma that si-

multaneously the demonstrations would be held in five Alabama cities and towns, including Birmingham, on Monday.

King led a poorly attended protest march in Montgomery Tuesday before going to Washington, and at Selma, around 200 Negro youths, apparently leaderless, silently picketed the Dallas County Courthouse.

At Jackson, Miss., federal Judge Harold Cox Tuesday told a Negro veteran of World War II, Edward Gray, that battle scars did not qualify him to vote. Gray testified in a suit by the Justice Department seeking a permanent injunction against Jefferson Davis County Registrar James Daniel, accused of discriminating against prospective Negro voters.

Gray, a high school graduate, said he thought if he was qualified to serve in the Army he could be registered to vote, but Cox replied that "battle scars or scars don't have anything to do with registering to vote."

Also in Jackson, Gov. Paul Johnson Tuesday called on Mississippi leaders to tell the "true story" of the state's racial situation to the U. S. Civil Rights Commission, which holds a hearing in Jackson today on alleged incidents of racial discrimination.

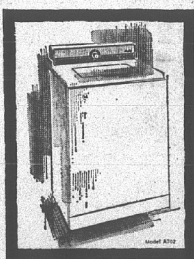
