Camp Fire Mints
Fine For Cooking
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12 chocolate mint patties
2 1/2 tablespoons sugar
4 tablespoons sweet or sour cream
1 teaspoon vanilla
For topping, melt patties over low heat, stirring constantly. Blend in sugar, cream and vanilla.
Cream butter, powdered sugar and salt. Add eggs and mix well. Add flour and mix thoroughly. Add nuts and vanilla. Form into small balls, press a deep hole in the center and fill with the chocolate mixture. Bake on an ungreased cookie sheet for 12 to 15 minutes at 375 degrees until golden brown. Cool and roll in powdered sugar if desired. Makes 2 1/2 to three dozen cookies.

CHOCOLATE CRACKLES
2 teaspoons milk
12 chocolate mint patties
1/2 cup butter or margarine
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 cup sugar
1 egg
2 tablespoons milk
2 cups sifted flour
1/2 teaspoon soda
1 teaspoon baking powder
Heat two teaspoons milk and patties over low heat, stirring constantly until melted. Cream butter, sugar and salt. Beat in egg, milk and chocolate mixture. Stir in flour, baking powder and soda, which have been sifted together. Drop by rounded teaspoonsful on lightly greased baking sheet. Bake 8 to 10 minutes at 400 degrees. Remove from cookie sheets immediately. Makes about three dozen. (This recipe was developed from a basic sugar cookie.)

Variation: Some or all of this batter may be turned into Rocky Road Cookies. For the whole recipe, stir in at the last 14-16 minutes marshmallows, or the equivalent in cut-up marshmallows, and one cup chopped nuts.

BURIED TREASURE COOKIES
1/2 cup butter or margarine
1 cup sugar
1 egg
1 tablespoon cream
2 cups flour
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon baking powder

Chocolate mint patties
Cream butter and sugar. Add egg and milk and mix well. Sift flour, salt and baking powder and add, mixing well. Roll out on floured board and cut in circles with cookie cutter. Put part or all of a mint patty in center, and cover with another circle, sealing edges with tines of a fork. Bake 25 degrees eight to 10 minutes. Makes 2 1/2 dozen.

CAMP FIRE MINT REFRIGERATOR DESSERT
1 cup powdered sugar
2 eggs
1/2 cup butter
16 chocolate mint patties
Graham-Cracker pie shell or crushed graham cracker crumbs

Melt patties over low heat, stirring constantly. Beat sugar and butter until smooth. Add eggs, one at a time, beating until smooth after each addition. Add melted patties. Spread in pie shell, or drop into paper baking cups lined with waxed paper. Chill for several hours or freeze. Serve with whipped cream. Serves six to eight.

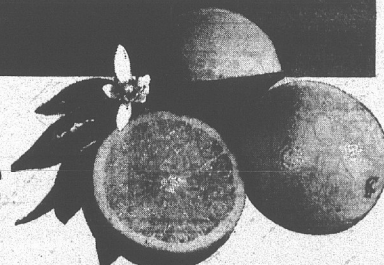
