

Widow With 4 Children Feels 'Just Forgotten'

Dear Ann Landers: I have been a widow for 10 years and I'm raising my four children alone. Here in America we have all kinds of organizations to help the needy. Red Cross, Salvation Army, Family Service, and even the Peace Corps for people in other countries. Why doesn't someone start an organization to help widows?

My husband died of a heart attack. He was my partner and my helmsman. Now he's gone. If the faucet leaks it costs \$1 to have it fixed. When appliances break down, the house needs repairing, or the car needs repairing, we widows have to pay the same prices as women with husbands. My sons would love to go hunting and fishing but I can't send them alone. My children are missing out on so many childhood joys because they have no father. Is it fair? Do you feel, as I do, that a national organization should be started to help us? — S. A. Y.

Dear S. A. Y.: I agree. Widows should be helped—particularly the widow who must work to support her children—but the type of help she needs can best be provided by a loving family (if she is lucky), considerate friends and thoughtful neighbors.

If widows were given free plumbing services, many divorced women would feel they were entitled to it, too. Then the widowed mother, and the woman whose husband walked out "temporarily," would say, "me too."

I am printing your letter as a reminder that fatherless children do miss a great deal, and they should not be forgotten. Dear Ann Landers: Recently you printed a letter from a young woman who wanted to know if it was proper to correct friends when they mispronounce a word or use improper grammar. She said she'd be grateful if her friends corrected her, but all she gets is dirty looks. You said most people respond being corrected, particularly in the presence of others. I con-

cur. This little poem (one I learned in high school) says it very well:

Call me a hypocrite, call me a thief;

Say that of liars, I am the chief.

Call me a scoundrel, say I'm too clever;

But regarding my grammar, correct me, please—never.

Dear Ann Landers: I'm a 20-year-old college junior. When I was 17 I fell in love with a boy 19. I may still be in love with him but I doubt it.

I am sure, however, that I will never be able to tolerate him. To make matters worse, my last weekend I suggested that we break up. He said, "If you dump me I will quit school and be a bum."

I don't want this on my conscience, Ann, yet I feel he is not the one for me and perhaps I am using this family stuff as an excuse to stop seeing him. Can you help me think my way through this muddled-up mess?
