

## Tule Youth Nabbed On Stolen Property Count

TULELAKE—A fifth youth, receiving stolen goods in the Tulelake Elementary School, Stanley Lyman, 16, was arrested Thursday for the theft of several hundred pounds of meat, vegetables in Tulelake Justice Court before Judge Victoria Thaler, and charged with receiving stolen property from the store of Judge Victoria Thaler, and

was taken to the Siskiyou County Jail in Yreka.

Others involved, who were arrested earlier, were Duane B. Carpenter, 18, Robert Duran, 19, and James Mauch, 22, all of Tulelake.

All appeared before Judge Thaler who set bail for each at \$1,500. With the exception of young Gallif, who remains in the county jail, the accused are free after posting of bail.

Chief of Police Jerry Ternas arrested Lyman, who lives with Gallif. Part of the food was given away; the remainder was thrown into a ditch and was spoiled.

Entry to the school building was through a rear window the weekend of Feb. 6-7. The food was removed from a walk-in freezer.



## Glass Aim Of Attacks

A rash of BB gun attacks on windows in homes and in autos hit Klamath Falls Tuesday night.

It was the latest in a series of such outbreaks in recent months.

Police Tuesday night and Wednesday morning investigated five incidents. They were:—Jack Eissler, 2202 Reclamation, reported a hole in the window of his car;

—A hole was shot in the front window of the Alameda Grocery;

—A picture window at the George Bose home, 1021 Washburn Way, was broken;

—A storm window was shattered at the Carlton Stelzer home, 226 White Avenue; and

—Another storm window was hit at the Donald Eck home, 2220 White.

Police believe all of the incidents are the work of the same person or persons as all occurred in the Mills Addition area.

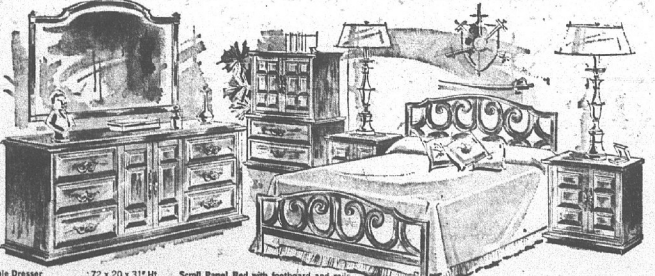
