

New Junior High School Constructed For Henley Area

200 Pupils Use Newly Built Unit

A new school to house about 200 seventh and eighth graders was completed at Henley last fall.

These students, pushed out of classrooms by mushrooming enrollments, had been housed in the gymnasium of the Henley High School while awaiting completion of the new facility.

The Henley Junior High School was built by Cummings Construction of Grants Pass under a \$418,072 contract.

It sits behind the present Henley Elementary and Henley High Schools on a 20-acre site.

The new school was designed by the Klamath Falls architectural firm of Morrison, Howard and Starbuck.

It was constructed of eight-inch-thick jumbo brick.

As designed by architect Murdo Morrison, the classrooms are clustered around courtyards.

The school features a "Y"-shaped roof which allows melting snow to drain down the center rather than drip from the edges.

The school boasts a large gymnasium. The building as now stands is the first of five units. The four other units will be built as they are needed to keep pace with enrollments, will be 1,200 students. Final capacity of the five units

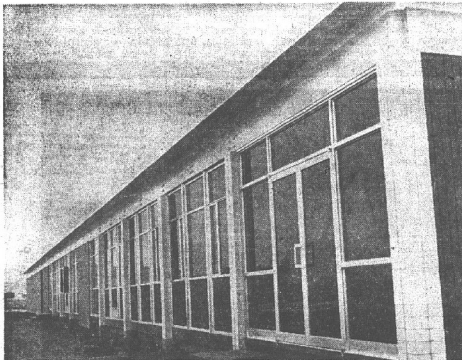

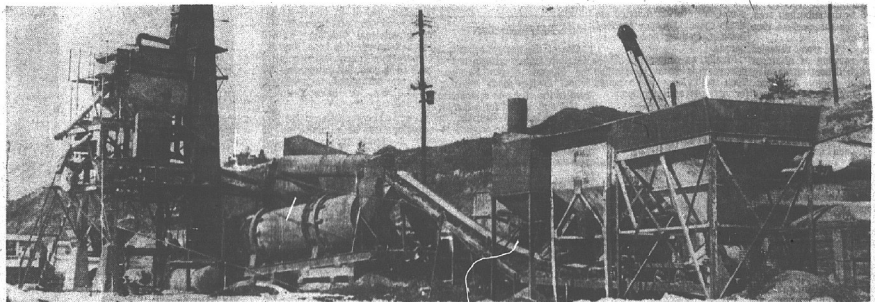
