Klamath County Schedules Ballot On School Board Posts For May 3

Three school boards posts will be filled by Klamath County voters at the annual schools election May 3.

The terms of three directors — one on each of the three boards — will expire this year.

The directors are Martha Powell, chairman of the City Elementary Board; Walt Bingham of the Klamath Union High School board, and B. M. Antle, chairman of the County School District board.

Deadline for candidates filing for three posts is April 2 — 30 days before the election.

None of the three directors has indicated if he will seek reelection.

Candidates for Mrs. Powell's seat must be a resident of the city elementary district. Candidates for Bingham's seat must live in the KUHSS southeast zone, which comprises generally the South Suburban area. Bingham was elected last year to a one-year term on the board, filling out an unexpired full term.

Deadline for candidates filing for three posts is April 2 — 30 days before the election.
