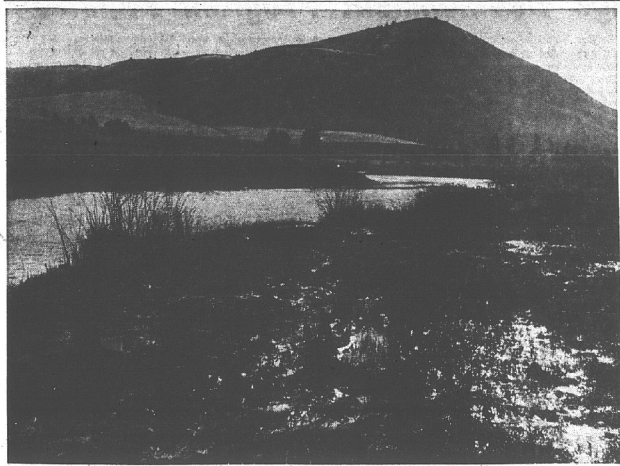

The development of Eagle Ridge as a recreation area with picnicking, camping and marine facilities is set to move past the drawing-board stage late next spring with efforts by the Klamath Forest Protective Association to establish a fire protection plan for the historic promontory.

Earl Kessler, director of county parks, disclosed that KFPAP's initial project on the "ridge" property will be to remove brush and debris along the one-lane road linking Shoalwater Bay to Eagle Point. The purpose of the project is to restore the road so four-wheel-drive motorized fire equipment can be moved into the area in the event of a fire, Kessler said. If funds are still available after completion of the fire protection project, the County Parks Commission will then undertake the next phase of the Eagle Ridge development — the construction of marine facilities along the lee side of Eagle Point. The plan for small craft facilities at the "Point" calls for the construction of a U-shaped dock to accommodate 10 boats.

Other recreation facilities to be constructed at the tip of the "ridge" where once stood the Eagle Ridge Lodge and Tavern which was destroyed by fire earlier this century, include a picnic area complete with barbecue pits and tables.

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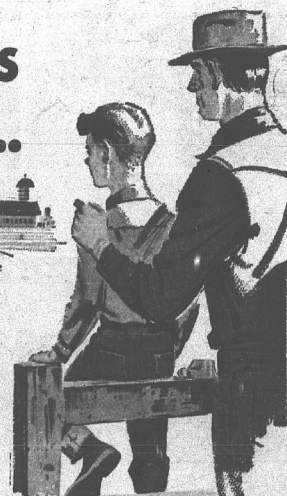
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
