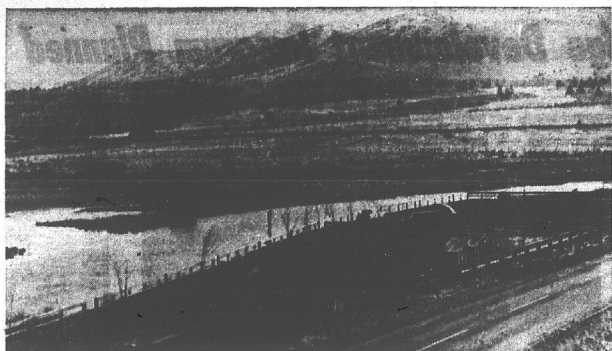




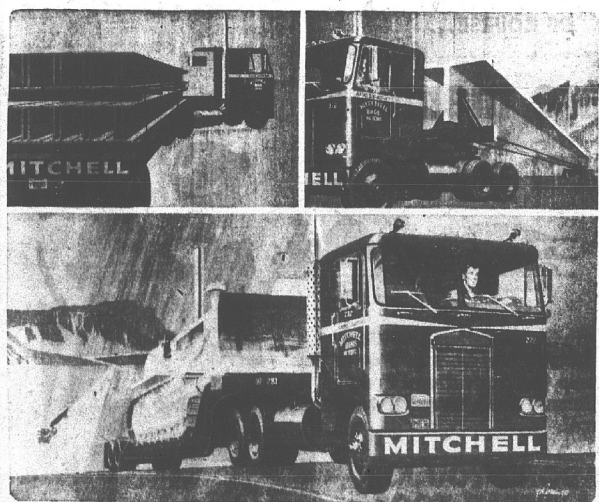
STEVENSON PARK — Lost River flows tranquilly past Stevenson Park, one of the county's few but extremely popular recreation facilities for fishermen and picnickers. Deeded to the county several years ago by the landowner whose name it honors, the picnic area is comprised of

a parking lot, picnic tables, comfort stations and a number of young trees. Later this year the County Park Commission will install a watering system from an irrigation set-up already in use near the river.



ROMANTIC ERA RECALLED — Plans announced by the County Parks Commission to develop Eagle Ridge as a recreation area has recalled the passing of an earlier era when that promontory was the site of the old Eagle Ridge Lodge and Tavern, since destroyed by fire. The hostelry had been on the itinerary of steamboats when that mode of transportation was popular on Upper Klamath Lake. Foundation stones of the razed structure mark the old lodge site, which will soon be available to tourists and recreationists as picnic grounds. The county acquired the property last year from the Oregon State Game Commission for \$10,000 with the final payment to be made before July, 1966.

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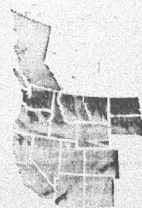


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Eagle Ridge Development Program Planned

Another watering system is slated to the county in memory of his late wife. Several of the trees were uprooted during the Christmas week storms but since then they have been replanted. Also scheduled for this spring is the landscaping and installation of a water system for a new park near the county fairgrounds. Kessler stated that

the landscaping job would be completed after several weeks before the end of this year. Funds for landscaping the area and for the planting of trees and shrubs will be allocated during 1966, when that portion of the project will be undertaken.

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
