Community Presbyterian Church of Tulalake had its beginning in Merrill, where on March 12, 1928 a meeting was held to discuss a plan for a south-end county parish. From this meeting, action was taken by Southwest Oregon Presbytery on April 10, 1928 to place the Tulalake area under the greater parish plan, which going into effect sometime after October 1, was known as the "Lost River Parish," and included the areas of Mt. Laki, Malin, Merrill and the home-stand area of Tulalake. The Rev. Stanley H. Jewell assumed duties of the parish on May 23, 1929 and among his many services organized the Westside and Eastside Sunday Schools during that year. When Tulalake townsite had the first government auction of lots in June, 1931, Rev. Jewell personally bought two lots on which the first unit of the Church was built. The cornerstone was laid Dec. 27, 1931 and dedication services were held on July 31, 1932, as the two Sunday Schools joined forces to become the nucleus of the growing

congregation, which was formally organized by the Presbytery on June 10, 1935. Of the 29 charter members, Mrs. G. W. Osborne, Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Weiskamp, Mrs. W. S. Edwards, Mrs. Vern Hemstreet, E. W. Staunton Jr., Mrs. Leonard Meshek, Mrs. Merton Brown, Wilbur Edwards and Mrs. Roy Campbell still serve as members of the congregation. The present membership exceeds 300. The Rev. Jewell is fondly remembered for his gigantic service to the foundation of the Christian work. Our first full time pastor was the Rev. Hugh L. Bronson who served over 9 years. During his pastorate the annex addition was constructed in 1937-38 by volunteer help, under the direction of Karl Gentry, Tulalake contractor, and the new sanctuary was added in 1948. Other pastors serving the congregation have been Reverends H. L. Weir, R. H. Stevensen, Merle Ramage, George Almond, Marvis Keyser and Arthur Johnson. The present pastor, Wayne E. Wattman, came in September, 1958.
